Annotated provisional agenda

1. Opening of the session

(a) Election of officers for 2004

The President and Vice-Presidents of the Executive Board represent the regional groups of the United Nations. In accordance with the rotation scheme established in decision 1992/7 (E/ICEF/1992/14), for 2004 the President will be nominated from among the African group of States which are members of the Board.

The provisional agenda has been drafted in consultation with the Bureau. The Executive Board will adopt the agenda for the session, making any amendments it considers necessary.

3. Report of the Executive Director (Part I): Annual report to the Economic and Social Council

[For action – E/ICEF/2004/4 (Part I)]

The report focuses on the triennial comprehensive policy review of United Nations operational activities for development and on the implementation of the reform programmes of the Secretary-General, as well other relevant decisions of the Council, including those on follow-up to international conferences and humanitarian and disaster relief assistance. The Board may wish to take note of the report and transmit it, together with the comments made by delegations at the present session, to the Council at its substantive session of 2004.

Under this agenda item, the Board will also consider an information note by the secretariat on recent reports of the Joint Inspection Unit (JIU) that are of relevance to UNICEF (E/ICEF/2004/5)

4. Approval of revised country programme documents (CPDs)

[For action]

At the Annual Session of 2003, the Executive Board commented on 13 draft CPDs (Angola, Benin, Congo, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Ecuador, Kenya, Madagascar, Niger, Pakistan, Philippines, Sierra Leone, Somalia and a consolidated document for Palestinian children and women in Jordan, Lebanon, Syrian Arab Republic and the occupied Palestinian territory) and approved the aggregate indicative budgets for the county programmes. In accordance with decision 2002/4 (E/ICEF/2002/8), the draft CPDs were revised, taking into account, as appropriate, comments made by delegations during that session, and summary results matrices were added. The revised CPDs, which were posted on the UNICEF internet site by 31 October 2003, will be approved by the Board at the current session on a no objection basis, unless at least five members informed the secretariat in writing by 12 December 2003 of their wish to bring a country programme before the Board.

In the light of alternative collaborative mechanisms that have developed since the establishment of the CCH in 1997, it is recommended to the Executive Boards of UNICEF, UNFPA and WHO that the CCH be discontinued and that the secretariats of the three agencies continue to strengthen other forms of coordination.
