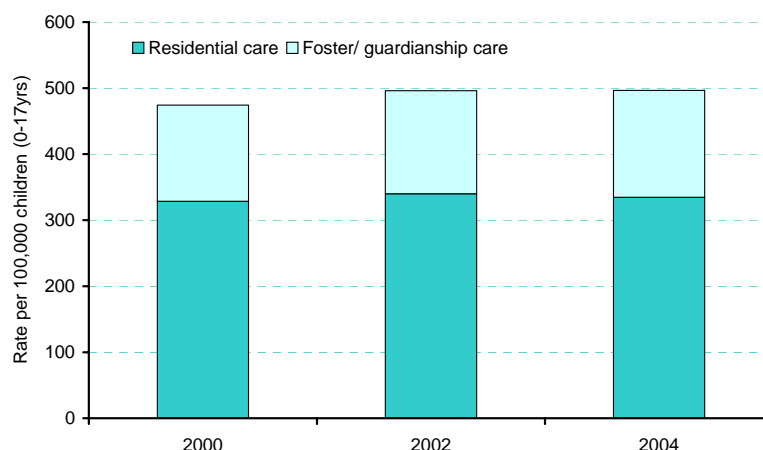

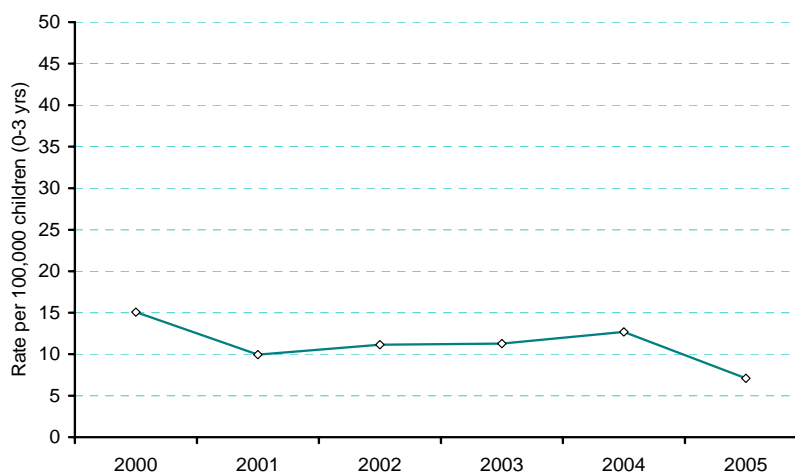

## Child Care Services in Montenegro<sup>7</sup>



### Definitions

**Boarding schools:** (fully state funded) at which the children receive board and lodging during the school term and sleep most nights at the school.

**Specialised day care:** Refers ONLY to day care that is part of child protection services, such as day care for children and families with socio-economic problems and children with special needs.
