"We are grateful to UNICEF for providing double windows and an efficient heating system at Sharipova School", continues Zarnigor Kushakova (12). "Although Sharipova School is a distance from our homes, it is not a problem because UNICEF provided seven buses which take us to school and back home."

When winter came, the Tolstoy school – the students, teachers, administration together with basic school materials – moved to share the building of the Sharipov School. UNICEF supported minibuses which went from house to house to collect children in the mornings and bring them back after school.
