## The Missing Link Between Poverty and Development

### **E. Valpy K. FitzGerald:**

E. Valpy K. FitzGerald is a University Reader in International Economics and Finance, Director of the Finance and Trade Policy Research Centre at Queen Elizabeth House, and Professorial Fellow of St Antony's College in Oxford University. The Trade Policy Research Centre focuses on the effect of changes in the global economy on sustainable development in poor countries, and the way in which the institutional arrangements established by the central economies affect world poverty. Prof. FitzGerald also holds a chair in economics at the Institute of Social Studies in The Hague. His research on international financial flows focuses on Latin America and Asia as major 'emerging markets', leading to proposals for the strengthening of multilateral regulatory systems for banking, taxation and multinational corporations. This work has involved advisory work for the ECLAC, OECD, UNCTAD and UNICEF as well as for Whitehall. A recent focus has been the potential for monetary union in the Americas. He is also engaged, with Rosemary Thorp, on research into long-term economic and social trends in Latin America over the whole twentieth century. Last, but not least, he maintains close contact with Nicaragua, lecturing each year at the Universidad Centroamericana in Managua. Prof. FitzGerald holds a PhD in Economics from Cambridge University in the U.K.
