

Orientation of the workshop

- Four organizations namely WHO, UNICEF, UNFPA and UNAIDS and 7 regional offices organize the workshop

- Three systems, MCH, FP and HIV/AIDS are involved
- Back to back meeting

Objective (day 1-3)

- 1) To share country experiences and lessons learnt in integrating prevention and management of STI/HIV/AIDS into reproductive, maternal and newborn service (*integration*)
- 2) to discuss the guideline for PCPNC and proposed a framework for *integration*
- 3) To develop recommendations for international organizations to collaborate with countries for *integration*

Objective (day 4-5)

- 1) To review and endorse framework on *integration* as primary prevention of comprehensive PMTCT approach
- 2) To strengthen evidence-based approaches to programming comprehensive PMTCT intervention
- 3) To review programmatic implications of comprehensive PMTCT, and recommend strategies and action plans to ensure all HIV positive pregnant women, their children and partners have access to care, treatment and support

Objective (day 4-5)

- 4) To update technical knowledge on latest PMTCT and paediatric ART guidelines, HIV testing for diagnostic, monitoring and quality improvement issues and other relevant studies
- 5) To draft individual country action plan for accelerated scaling up of services in order to achieve global commitments on PMTCT
