M Ramesh is Professor of Social Policy in the Department of Social Work and Social Administration at the University of Hong Kong. Previously, he held teaching positions at the National University of Singapore, University of Sydney, University of New England and Victoria University of Wellington.

His teaching and research is concentrated in public policy and political economy in Asia. His recent publications have been in the area of public policy and governance in income maintenance and health policy sectors in Asia.

He is the author or co--author of *Studying Public Policy* (3rd edition, 2008), *Social Policy in East and Southeast Asia* (2004), *Welfare Capitalism in Southeast Asia* (2000); *Political Economy of Canada* (2nd edition, 1999). He is the editor or co-editor of *Reasserting the Public in Public Services* (forthcoming, 2009), *Transforming Asian Governance* (2008), and *Deregulation and Its Discontents* (2004). In addition, he has published numerous articles in senior refereed journals. He is also the editor of the journals *Policy and Society*, and *World Political Science Review*, in addition to serving on the editorial board of several journals.
