

**Job Opportunity**  
**Consultancy on Evaluation of Accelerated Learning and Multi-grade Teaching Programmes**  
**( Forty Five Day Consultancy)**

The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) is seeking to hire a qualified consultant to support Department of Primary Education (PED) of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport (MoEYS) in conducting an Evaluation of the Accelerated Learning and Multi-grade Teaching Programmes. The incumbent will be based at the Primary Education Department of MoEYS in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, with travelling to some provinces where the programmes are carried out.

**Main Duties and Responsibilities**

- Desk review relevant materials related to Accelerated Learning Programme and Multi-grade teaching in Cambodia.
- Undertake consultations with relevant stakeholders including different MoEYS departments (PED, CDD, TTD), UNICEF (Phnom Penh staff and provincial staff), Save the Children Norway and World Bank/FTI.
- Undertake field visits to observe and collect information in Kampong Speu, Prey Veng and Stung Treng.
- Conduct a one-day consultative workshop to disseminate findings of the study and provide recommendation on improving and up scaling AL and MG programmes for relevant ministry officials.
- Based on the outcomes of the review, data collection and consultations:
  - To suggest recommendations for MoEYS and UNICEF office on further expansion/development of Accelerated Learning and Multi-grade (AL and MG) teaching programmes.
  - To suggest recommendations to strengthen quality of the programmes.
  - To suggest recommendations for CFS Master Plan 2011-2015.
- Prepare a Power Point presentation on the findings and final consultancy report.

**Minimum Qualifications and Experience**

- Advanced university degree, preferably in education.
- Eight years of progressively responsible work experience in education programme evaluation.

**Skills/Competencies**

- Knowledge of Accelerated Learning and Multi-grade Teaching Approaches.
- Strong evaluation skills.
- Knowledge of Cambodian education system is an asset.
- Excellent writing skills and communication skills.
- Demonstrated ability to work in a multicultural environment (specific knowledge of Khmer and working experiences in Cambodia are an asset).
- Proficiency in English and knowledge of Khmer is an asset.
