POLIO ERADICATION ACTIVITIES IN ETHIOPIA

- 2000 Polio National Immunization Days (house-to-house and fixed-site campaigns)
Targeted: 11,492,876 children under five-years-old
First round: 12,546,413 children vaccinated
Second round: 13,100,800 children were vaccinated
Vitamin A supplemented to 6,577,735 children between the ages of six months to five years
- 2000 Sub-National Immunization Days (SNIDs)
Targeted: 385,123
First Round: 397,351
Second round: 409,705
- 2001 Polio National Immunization Days (house-to-house throughout the country)
Targeted: 13,655,184 children under five-years-old
First round: 13,692,177 vaccinated
Second round: 14,064,483 vaccinated
Total cost, including oral polio vaccine: \$16 million
Estimated operational cost per immunized child: \$0.60

Targeted: 1,399,106

Targeted: 14,189,790

- The polio immunization days in 2004 is targeted 750,000 under 5 years old children from high risk areas. The Sub National Immunization Days will be conducted in selected 21 Woredas of East Shoa, West Shoa and Southwest Shoa zones of Oromia region.

2004 Sub National Immunization Days

Targeted: - 750,000 children age 0 months to 59 months

First round will be conducted from October 22- 25th 2004

Second round will be in December 2004.
