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**Introduction:**

A recent outbreak of fighting in the DR Congo has seen thousands of people displaced, hundreds killed, and has awoken the world again to a conflict that is thought to have killed 3.3 million Congolese since 1998. Of the hundreds of thousands of children who have died, the vast majority have died because of malnutrition and preventable diseases. They continue to die at an alarming rate, but most often silently and hidden from the glare of publicity. The DRC is chronically under-funded. It is the classic “forgotten emergency.”

Violence between rival ethnic militias follows the withdrawal of Ugandan forces from north-east DR Congo at the beginning of May. A small lightly-armed UN force already is in the province trying to halt atrocities that have caused thousands of civilians to flee.

Many internally displaced children and adults have sought shelter from the fighting factions in and near the United Nations compound (MONUC).
