RESOLVE

We, Members of Parliament, cutting across parties, resolve that we will address the critical problem of child malnutrition in India. Today almost half our children under the age of three are malnourished and it calls for an urgent and effective response.

We resolve that we will take up the issue within Parliament and outside it, with Governments, at the Centre and in states, and with civil society, to tackle this alarming situation.

We are aware that governments have been making an effort and there has been an increase in budgetary allocations. But more needs to be done. The situation must now be addressed on a war footing, backed by national will and a determination to find solutions. We have to rise above all differences to give a better future to our children.
