Reba was 15 years old and studied in school. She was very upset because her father was discussing her marriage.

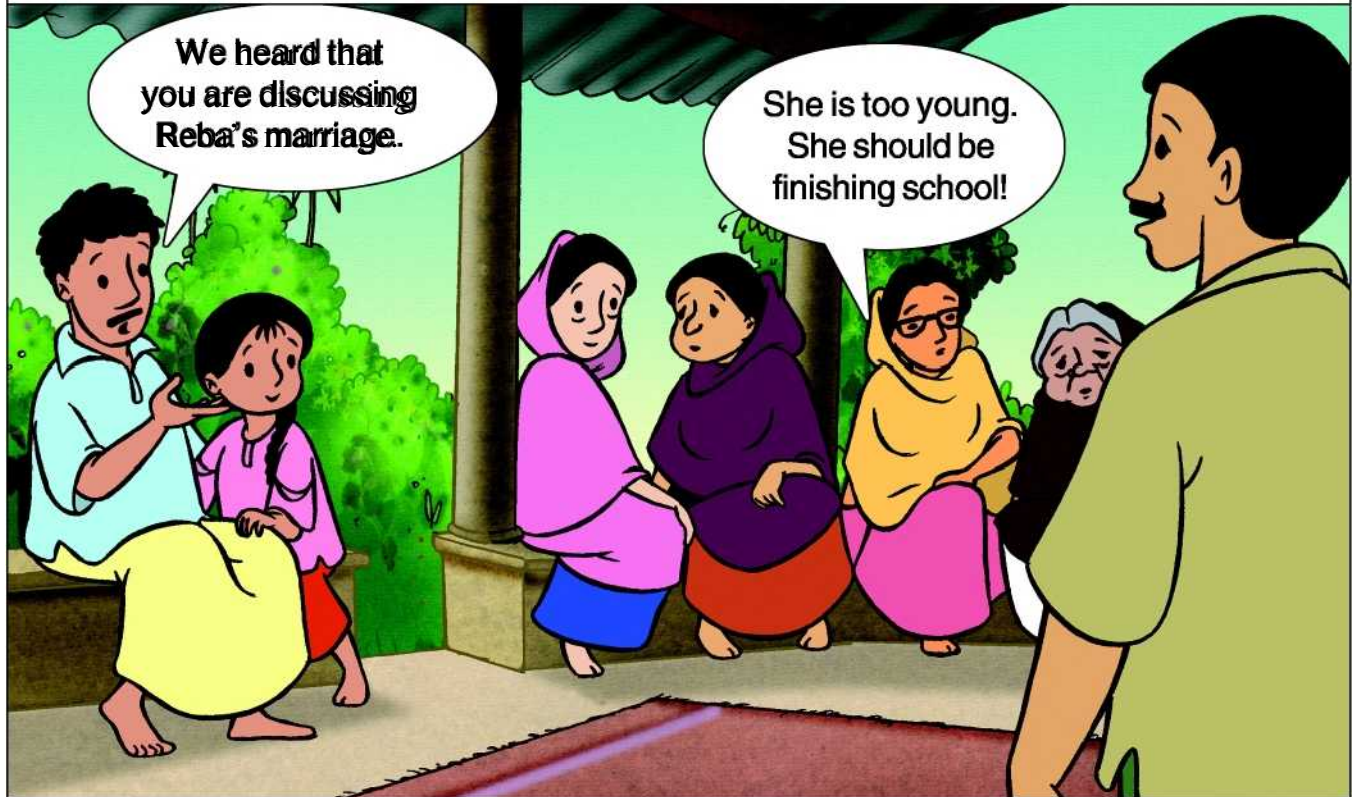


Meena was sad when she heard this. She knew that it is important to finish school and that girls should not marry before the age of 18.

Grandma offered to help too. She promised to speak to Reba's parents.



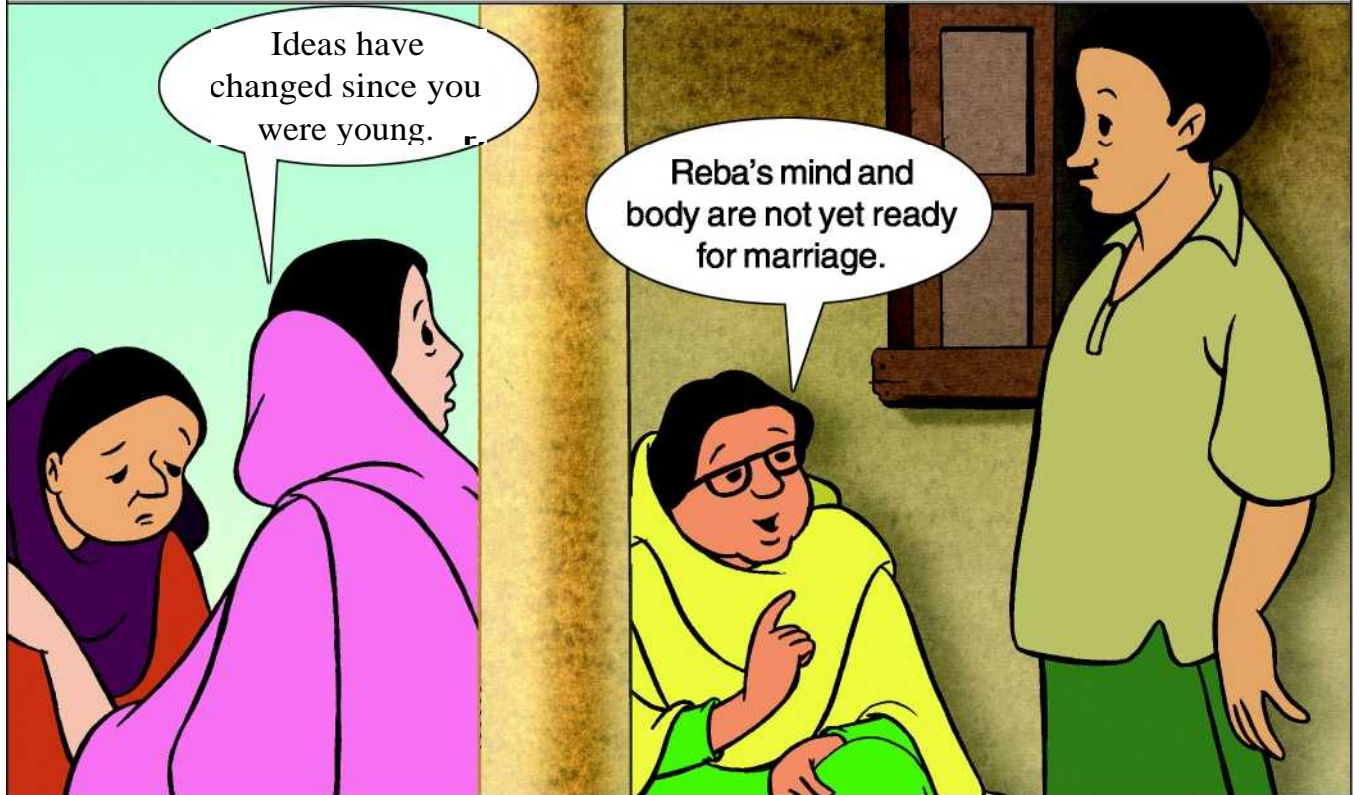
Grandma and Meena kept their word. They talked to Meena's parents, the school teacher and the village health worker. Soon the whole group turned up at Reba's house.
