

# KEY FACTS

## Infant mortality rate (per 1,000 live births)

- National average: 6.7 (2010)
  - Roma: 14 (down 44% since 2005)

## Nutrition

### Exclusive breastfeeding to six months

- National average: 14%
  - Urban: 16%
  - Rural: 11%
  - Roma: 9%

### Continued breastfeeding at one year

- National average: 18%
  - Male children: 24%
  - Female children: 14%
  - Roma: 54%

### Low birthweight

- National average: 5%
  - Poorest: 8%
  - Richest: 3%
  - Roma: 10%

### Underweight under-fives

- National average: 1.6%
  - Poorest: 3%
  - Roma: 7%
  - Poorest Roma families 10%

### Stunting (under-fives who are too short for their age)

- National average: 7%
  - Poorest: 9.3%
  - Roma: 24%
  - Poorest Roma: 39%

## Early childhood education and learning

### Pre-school programme attendance (36-59 months)

- National average: 44%
  - Urban: 57%
  - Rural: 29%
  - Richest: 78%
  - Poorest: 22%
  - Roma: 8%

### Percentage of households with children under 5 that have at least 3 books for children:

- 76% of households on an average
- 49% of the poorest households
- 23% of Roma households
