

# KEY FACTS

## Primary School Education

### Primary school enrolment at age seven:

- National average: 95%
  - Roma: 91% (up 37% since 2005)

### Primary school attendance:

- National average: 99%
  - Roma: 89% (up 20% since 2005)
  - Roma girls: 87%

### Net primary school completion at age 14:

- National average: 92%
  - Rural: 88%
  - Poorest: 72%
  - Roma: 35% (up 21% since 2005)

### Secondary school attendance:

- National average: 89%
  - Children whose mothers have only primary education: 74%
  - Poorest: 61%
  - Roma: 19% (up 89% since 2005)
  - Roma girls: 16%

## Violent disciplining of children

### Children who experienced physical punishment as a method of disciplining:

- National average: 37%
  - In households where head of household has only primary education: 45%
  - In households where head of household has only high/higher education: 26%
