We wanted to make a rainbow surprise for our little sister and we went to the market with our granny.





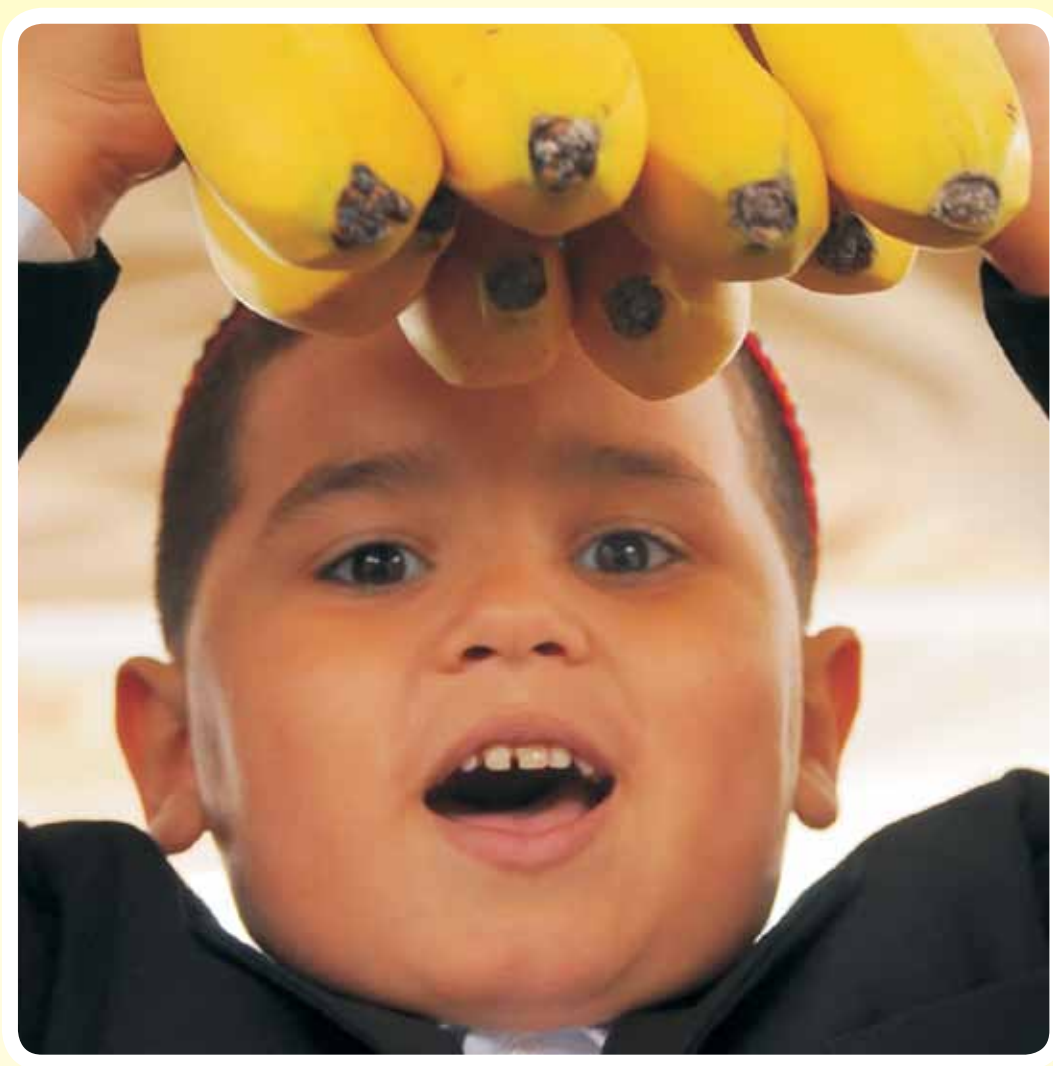
- Do you remember the colours of a rainbow? Let's find them.
