and another one is bound for Monday and this is also major medical supplies including specialized obstetrics care including for infants and young children all the materials that will be needed to give the support they need in this dire situation. The problem is that even though this material is very close to Gaza—Jerusalem is next door—but it takes amazing time just to get there with the crossing and so forth and if we can negotiate more crossings to be open then we can accelerate our response. But we are operating right now in extreme conditions.”

“We have a fairly good idea of what are the needs but we desperately need more resources, especially from national committees and their donor partners.”

“What we are aiming at is to ensure that the ceasefires are increased day by day not three hours, its just not enough and we want also to ensure that there is a durable peace agreement that will allow all parties to be able to have access to the population but a durable peace agreement is what we are all aiming at. In the near future what we are looking at is to be able to have a a set of activities, life saving but also looking at the psycho social, the level of trauma in the population, especially children and we have full teams ready to be deployed to go to Gaza. As we speak we have dozens of people ready to move in but right now it’s just not possible.”

“Right now we are revising our Humanitarian Action Report and the revised report which will be launched on this Sunday, in two days is for 16 million dollars which is the new requirement. The HAR is the tool that we are using globally to support countries in crises and this is launched on an annual basis and we are reviewing it as the situation evolves on the ground and we are working with the country office and Geneva to review that. And it’s been revised upward to ensure that we have the necessary resources.”
