UNICEF Executive Director Ann Veneman, has announced a US\$5 million incentive package, aimed at rescuing the ailing Zimbabwean health sector. Speaking at the end of her two day visit to Zimbabwe, Ms. Veneman highlighted the need for major stakeholders to put children at the forefront of their collective agenda.

SOT Ann Veneman [English] "I've had several meetings with stakeholders, members of the government, ministers, President Mugabe as well as many other stakeholders, members of the donor community, members of the NGO community, so its been a most interesting trip and one that has informed me in terms of the situation here in Zimbabwe."

The visit by Ms. Veneman; the first by a head of a UN agency in three years, comes in at a time when Zimbabwe is faced by an unprecedented cholera outbreak which has claimed more than 2 000 lives over the last four months, and a heightened humanitarian crisis which has seen the collapse of the health and education sectors in the country. During her visit, Ms. Veneman visited Budiro treatment centre, one of the 70 centres, set up in response to the raging outbreak. She had the opportunity to speak with some of the patients admitted in the wards.

Zimbabwe’s cholera outbreak has been aggravated by the failing social services in Zimbabwe. Through the supply of clean water to suburbs; support to cholera treatment centres and provision of water purification tablets, UNICEF has worked at ensuring the minimal loss of life to a disease which is not only preventable, but curable.

SOT Ann Veneman [English] “Well the situation seems to be improving somewhat at least in the centre we visited, there is still not control of this epidemic and we understand that in rural areas it continues to progress so much more needs to be done to address cholera.”

During her visit to Zimbabwe, Ms. Veneman also visited an orphan care project in Mabvuku, a project set up as a catch up learning facility for orphans who have not enrolled into the formal schools. In the face of the mounting problems in Zimbabwe, orphan vulnerability has increased in the areas of food security, school attendance and health care. Under the programme of support in Zimbabwe, UNICEF is supporting over 250 000 Zimbabwean orphans to meet their health; educational and medical requirements. Ms Veneman also met with government and private counterparts.

As Zimbabwe’s social and economic decline continues, UNICEF has committed itself to helping heal an ailing system.
