	<p>Script</p> <p>Children in class at the number 31 Kindergarten in the city of Rustavi in Georgia.</p> <p>Many teachers are still using the methods developed during the former Soviet era.</p> <p>Teaching is highly structured.</p> <p>Few toys and games offer little to stimulate young minds.</p> <p>But changes in early childhood learning methods are in progress here.</p> <p>This is just one of many kindergartens in Georgia where UNICEF is helping to improve early childhood education.</p> <p>In pilot classes, teachers trained in new methods are offering children more interactive and dynamic early learning environments.</p> <p>Children are learning through playing.</p> <p>More educational activities, games and toys are available to stimulate child learning and curiosity. Now, her teachers say she's thriving.

Through better teacher training UNICEF is aiming to not only improve teaching methods but show teachers how to identify learning difficulties or signs of trauma a child might be experiencing.
