Voice over:

As an outbreak of polio sweeps across Indonesia, precious drops of vaccine immunize the children of this Jakarta neighborhood from this highly contagious disease ...that leaves crippled children in its wake.

Across Indonesia's 6000 islands, some 240 cases of wild polio have been reported since March. Before that Indonesia had been polio-free for ten years. But polio now threatens the whole region.

In Giriijaya, high in the West Java hills, children at risk play in the Ciliwung river .Polio spreads through contaminated water such as this.

Here, two year Fikri, must now learn to walk for the second time in his life...this time with braces strapped to his legs.

Fikri was the first child in his country to contract polio. Ten more villagers succumbed later on. Before this outbreak less than half of the children of Giriijaya had been immunized.

Back in Jakarta health workers go door to door checking vaccination records and dyed fingertips. Mothers line up at the health center. One more child of the 24.6 million left to be vaccinated.
