### SCRIPT:

One year after surviving the tsunami that killed his brother, his sister and his grandparents, 10-year old Iwan from Indonesia is slowly recovering from the shock. He was so traumatised by the events of that day the he couldn't remember his parents name or address. Thanks to a stoke of luck and a UNICEF-supported tracing programme he was eventually reunited with his parents.

Soundbite Hayatun Nafis, Iwan's mother: "When Iwan came back and I could hold him in my arms again, I always tried my best to calm him. I try to help him get rid of the trauma."

Working with governments and partners across the affected region, UNICEF continues to help reunite children with family members and provide more than 300,000 children with emotional support.

Even before the tragedy, UNICEF had a presence in all the affected countries and was able to respond immediately by providing shelter, clean water, immunisation and even temporary schools.
