You're watching UNICEF television.

Children displaced by fighting in Pakistan have harrowing memories of the violence they have witnessed.

SOT Ajmal, 8 years old:

"Airplanes would come and drop bombs. There were mortar shells hitting our house. We children would cry. On the way it was very difficult and we could not walk especially the little children and we had to carry them on our backs"

Of the millions of people forced to leave their homes by the fighting, many are relying on the kindness of strangers.

SOT Mr. Lajwar, Owner of sugar mill

"These people arrived in a terrible state with absolutely nothing. I emptied my sugar mill for them as there was no room left in my house. We are poor people and do not have enough resources. We are sharing whatever food and clothes we have with them. These people urgently need assistance like health facilities, education, food and clothes."

This sugar mill housing six families who've escaped the fighting in Swat.

"At the moment they're not receiving any education or health or food rations and the need is very urgent."

UNICEF is providing basic services for the displaced but because so many like these are staying private homes its difficult for humanitarian aid to reach them.
