If we look at the problems faced by Educational Institutions (High schools or others..) we will surely notice that Violence in schools is becoming a widespread event especially in Primary schools where students are exposed to punishment and where there is no way to protect them from this harm. This is because teachers consider punishment as a way of deterrence and find it the best way to education taking advantage of the fact that students are weak.

The problems in high schools are different: most of the time there is a complete role reversal where the student becomes the aggressor and the teacher is the victim. The aggression could be through bullying or intimidation and leads to a conflicting situation.

The circle of violence in schools could also go beyond this issue and includes violence of students among themselves. This is what we live through in our school life. It is true that violence among students is very limited in our school, but nevertheless significant solution should be found. There are many reasons of violence among students:

1. Difficult social conditions in which the student is facing. He lives within a family where dialogue does not exist due to the generation gap. This could negatively affect the student's psychological reactions and behaviour facing problems aggressively.
2. Some students try to prove themselves in different ways. They did not succeed in their studies and have a feeling of inferiority, incapacity and helplessness. This leads them to attract attention by creating an atmosphere of chaos in schools...

The teacher plays a major role in identifying the relation between himself and his student. It is HE who decides about the means in which the student is to be punished (intimidation, corporal punishment).

Such rude means and bad mannered behaviors work against the noble mission of schools and implant in students uncivilized behavior and lack of respect. This is why it is necessary to find solutions to overcome this problem; among these solutions:

1. Family's awareness of the importance of its role in a good education. Parents should help their children prevent using violence by strengthening their capacity for respect, using dialogue against physical means. This will firmly implant their self esteem.
2. Teachers' role to limit this phenomenon by stopping to provoke and bully students. Teachers should be open to dialogue and discussion. Their educational mission should not be restricted to learning and teaching but to dialoguing, negotiating and discussing especially when this is lacking among the students' families and societies....

It is also important to provide students with places in which they could express themselves and move away from any form of violence.

We must remember the role our schools have played in rationalizing students' behavior and involving parents in this issue. This has started by creating listening and orientation cells in which psychologists, educators and sociologists exercise their duties.
