# Greater Kapoeta Focal Area

(Kapoeta E., Kapoeta N., Kapoeta S>, Budi Counties of E Equatoria State)

**January – August 2008**

- **Epidemiology**

- **1,310 cases (42% of S. Sudan total) in 380 villages**
- **56% reduction in cases in 2007 (KE -71%, KN -57%, KS +28%)**
- **696 endemic villages (KE -498, KN -116, KS -82)**
- **2,076 villages under active surveillance**
- **55 villages with 5+ cases. = 57% total (742/1,310)**
- **9% 0-5 years, 40% 6-15 years, 41% 16-35 years, 10% 36+ years**
- **45% males, 55% females**
- **Toposa**

# Greater Kapoeta Focal Area

**January – August 2008**

- **Interventions**

**55% containment rate**

**94% monthly reporting rate**

**99% (688/696) EV with monthly health education**

**71% (492/696) EV with 100% cloth filter coverage**

**56% (389/696) EV with pipe filter coverage eligibles**

**57% (400/696) EV targeted with Abate**

**18% (128/696) EV with 1+ safe water**

# Greater Kapoeta Focal Area

(Kapoeta E., Kapoeta N., Kapoeta S>, Budi Counties of E Equatoria State)

**January – August 2008**

- **SSGWEP Personnel Infrastructure**
  - **95% trained VV, monthly supervisory visits**
  - **Pilot CCC at Jie (KE); establishing 2 more at KS, KN**
  - **1 major logistics hub, 1 sub office, 6 program stores**
  - **Personnel?**
  - **105 new boreholes, 4 mechanized; KN 25%→58% coverage**
