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| Current composition & structure of coordination groups & mechanisms for health and HIV/AIDS, under a government lead |
| The organs of coordination include the structures of the State, the Partners Technical and Financial (PTF), the community, the civil company, the departments narrowly implied such as the Ministry for the Economy and Finances, the Ministry for the Social Development of Solidarity and the Old People, the Ministry for the Territorial Administration and the Local Communities, the Ministry for the Promotion of the Woman of the Child and Family etc ... Coordination is done through sessions of the technique, steering committees, of follow-up and national days of evaluation at the central level. On the level of the areas and districts, are organized respectively the Committees of Orientation, Coordination and Evaluation of the PRODESS and the boards of trustees. In addition, of the joint missions Government+ PTF are organized on the ground. |

| The financing of the sector of Health is ensured by the budget of the State through the MEF and the communities, the PTF through the agreements of financing and ONG, the community through the covering of the costs. |
| Health system and agency bottlenecks and constraints that have already been recognized as needing to be removed by inclusion in national plans and review mechanisms. |
| Good MBB simulation at the basis of MTEF. Insufficient human resources, equipment and institutional weakness are the main bottlenecks. |

| Workshop held in Nov. 2007 (Government +PTF and civil society) preparing a joint PRSP matrix, results framework to link to the compact. |
