## Context

Project aims 50 000 people among which 10 000 children all specifically affected by the political crisis in term of water and sanitation. Targeted communities are particularly vulnerable and known as guinea worm endemic and have not sufficiently benefited from humanitarian assistance in terms of access to water, sanitation and hygiene. Communities in selected areas belong also to the most vulnerable and impoverished due to crisis.

**Objective: Empower at least hundred (100) rural displaced communities resettling in original villages after crisis through access to potable water, sanitation facilities and hygiene promotion.**

- Access to sustainable water and sanitation facilities and capacity building in 100 villages in 4 departments in Côte d'Ivoire (Béoumi, Dabakala, Mankono, Zuénoula);
- Improved governance and social cohesion through water supply management;
- Activities include reinforcement of hygiene promotion and community education.

## Impact: What has been achieved?

- Community diagnosis have been undertaken;
- Local communities are being mobilized and capacity building activities have started with technical and social staff ;
- Water systems establishment in communities as well as in health centers is underway;
- Community support for demonstration latrines construction is going on among which Ecosan and Sanplat latrines;
- Hygiene promotion campaigns are underway.
