Changes summary!

Eligibility criteria and duration broadened

- Undergraduates respecting the minimum age of 18 replaces the requirement of having completed two years if enrolled in a bachelor's degree.
- Recent graduates are allowed until 2 years after degree completion.
- Maximum duration of 26 weeks, regardless of academic requirement.

Engagement of family members as interns discouraged

- Clarification that interns cannot have immediate relatives working in any UNICEF office as well as no relatives in the line of authority which the intern will report to .

Payment of a stipend encouraged

- We encourage offices to pay interns a stipend as a contribution towards living expenses and a one-time lump sum as a contribution towards travel and visa costs if applicable, subject to availability of funding .
