In addition to strengthening health systems, UNICEF helped to reshape food systems to deliver nutritious diets for children and to prevent all forms of malnutrition: 74 countries rolled out large-scale food fortification programmes with UNICEF support. In 2017, 15.6 million children benefited from micronutrient powders containing essential vitamins and minerals; 23 million caregivers were counselled on optimal infant feeding practices; and over 255 million children were reached with two doses of vitamin A supplementation.
