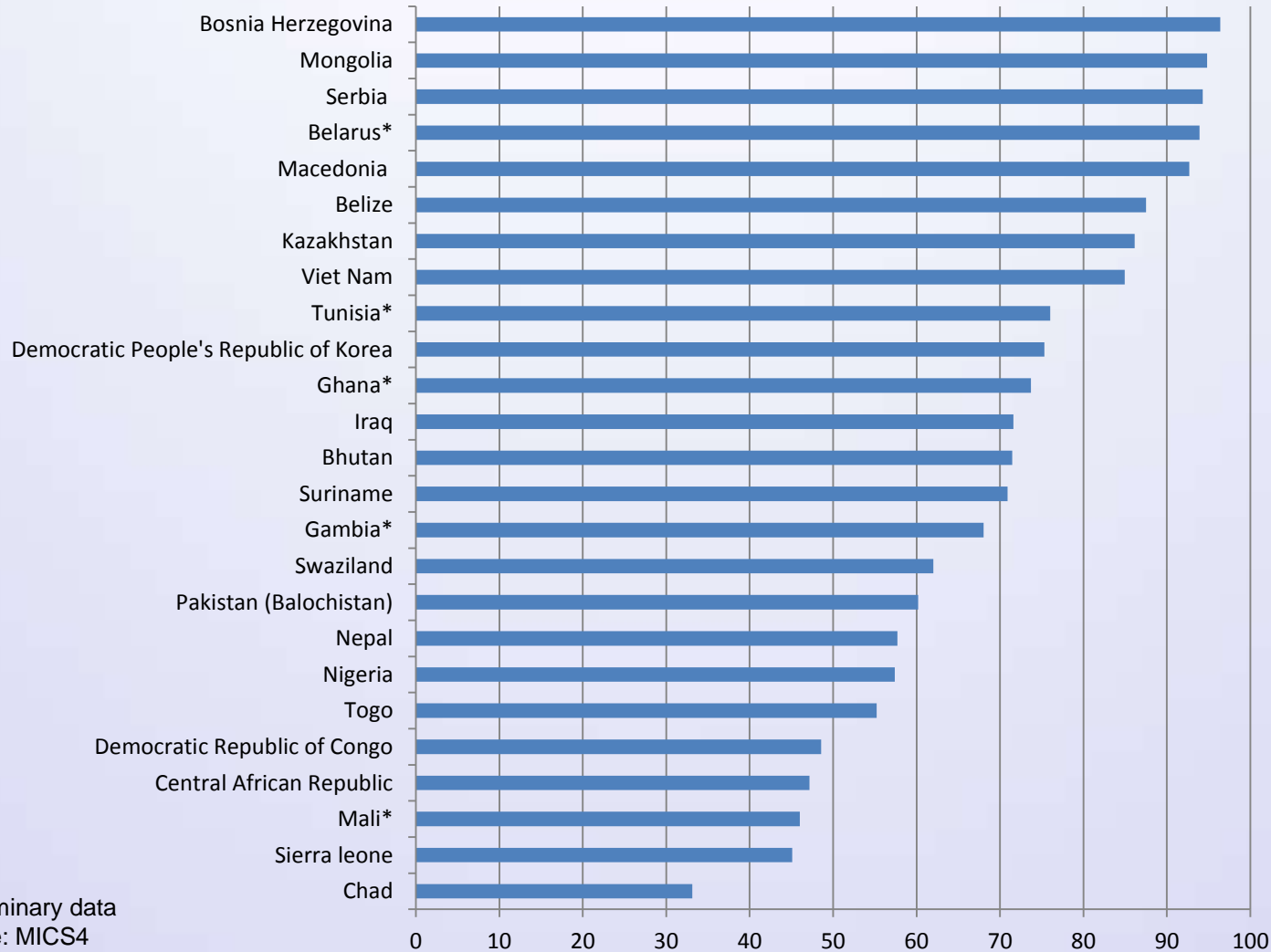

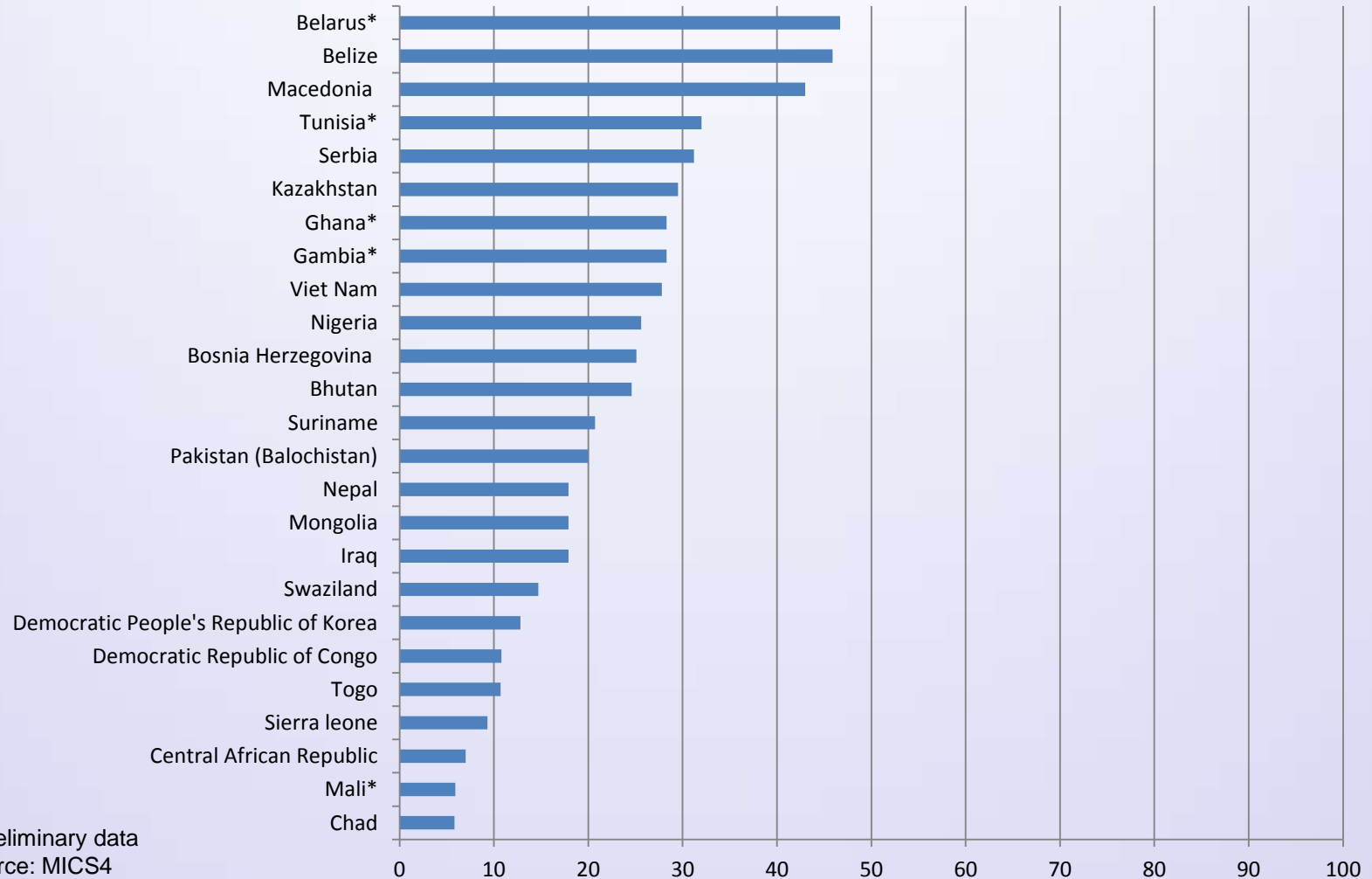

ECD Index Literacy-numeracy



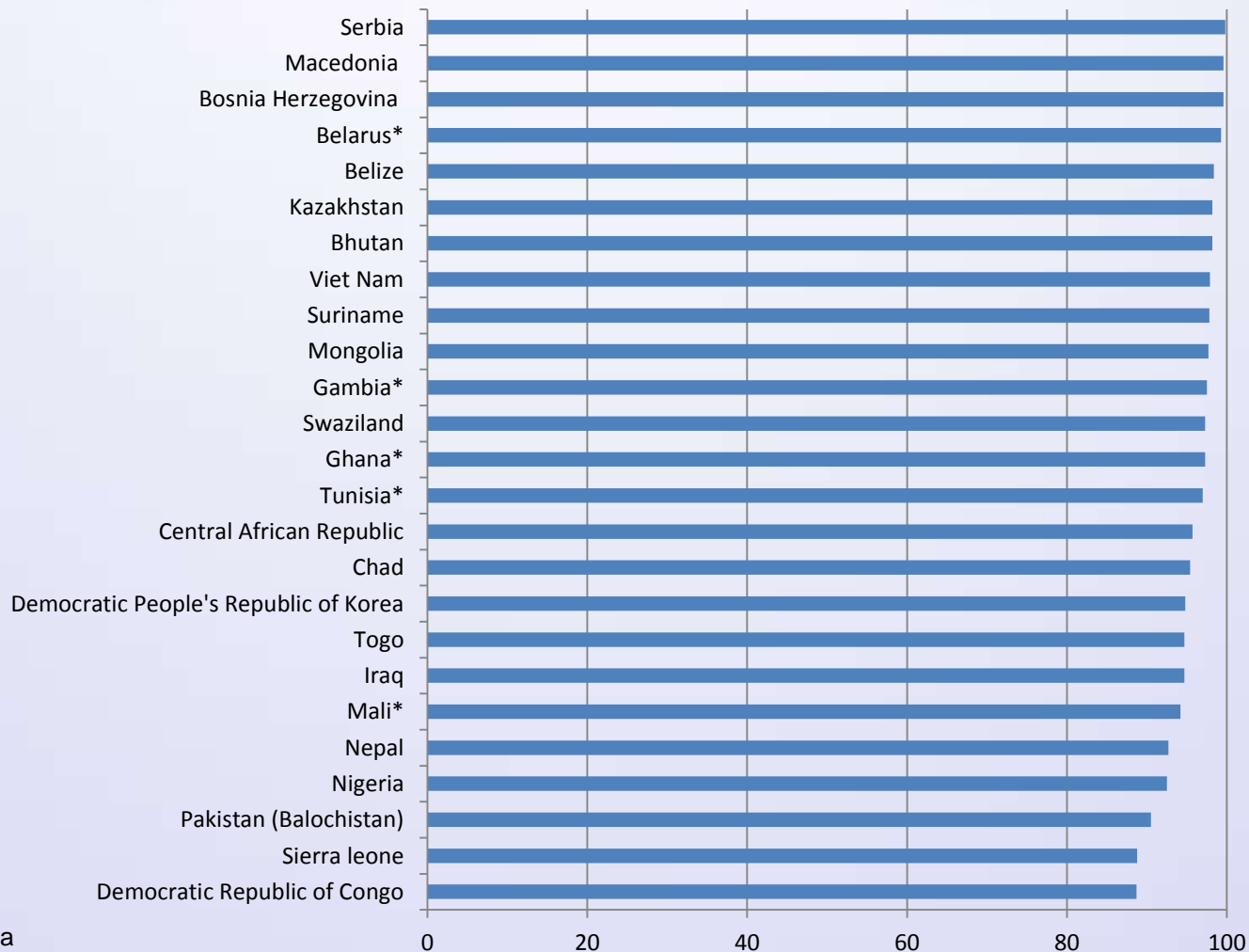

Percentage of children age 36-59 months who are developmentally on track in social-emotional domain

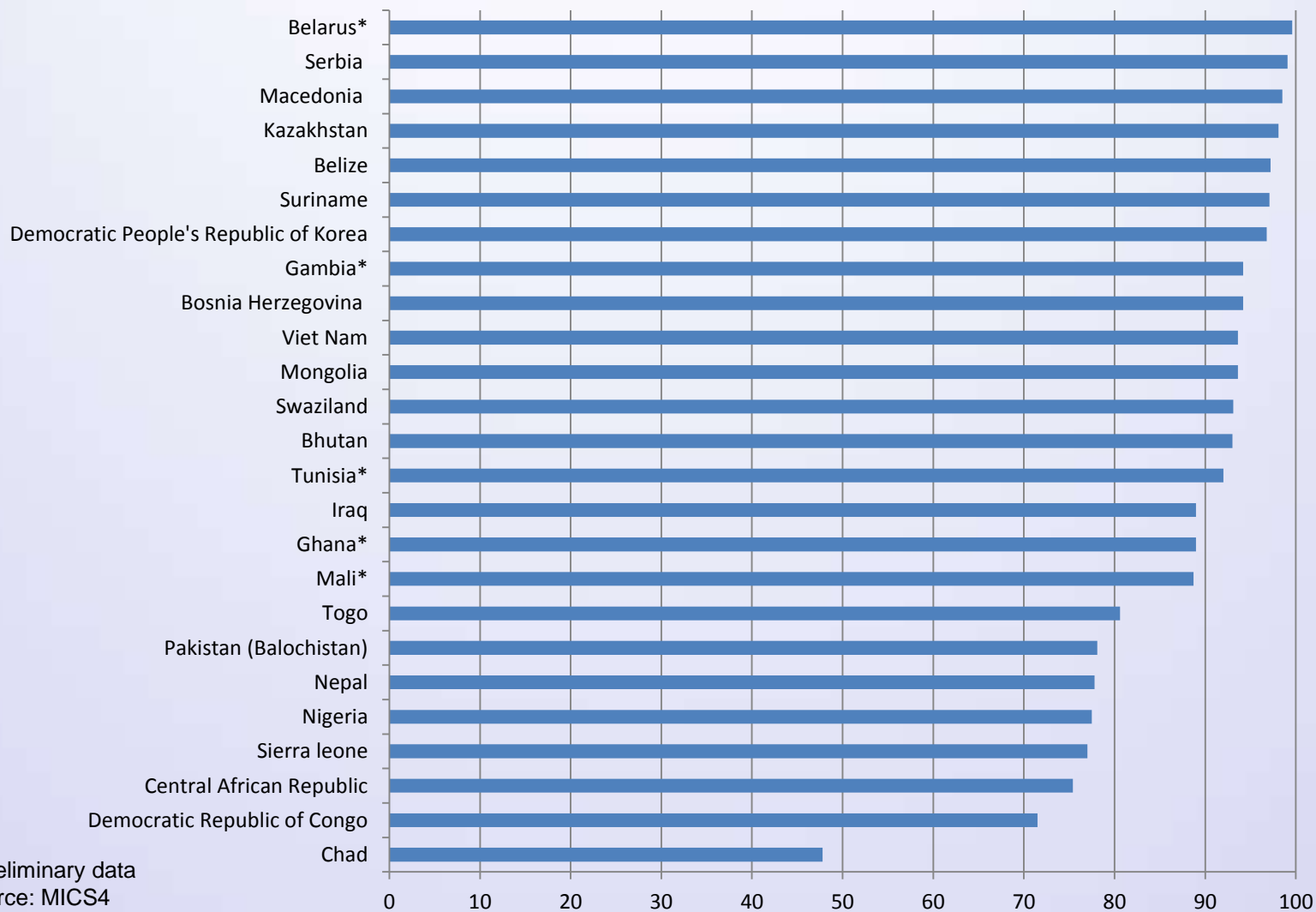

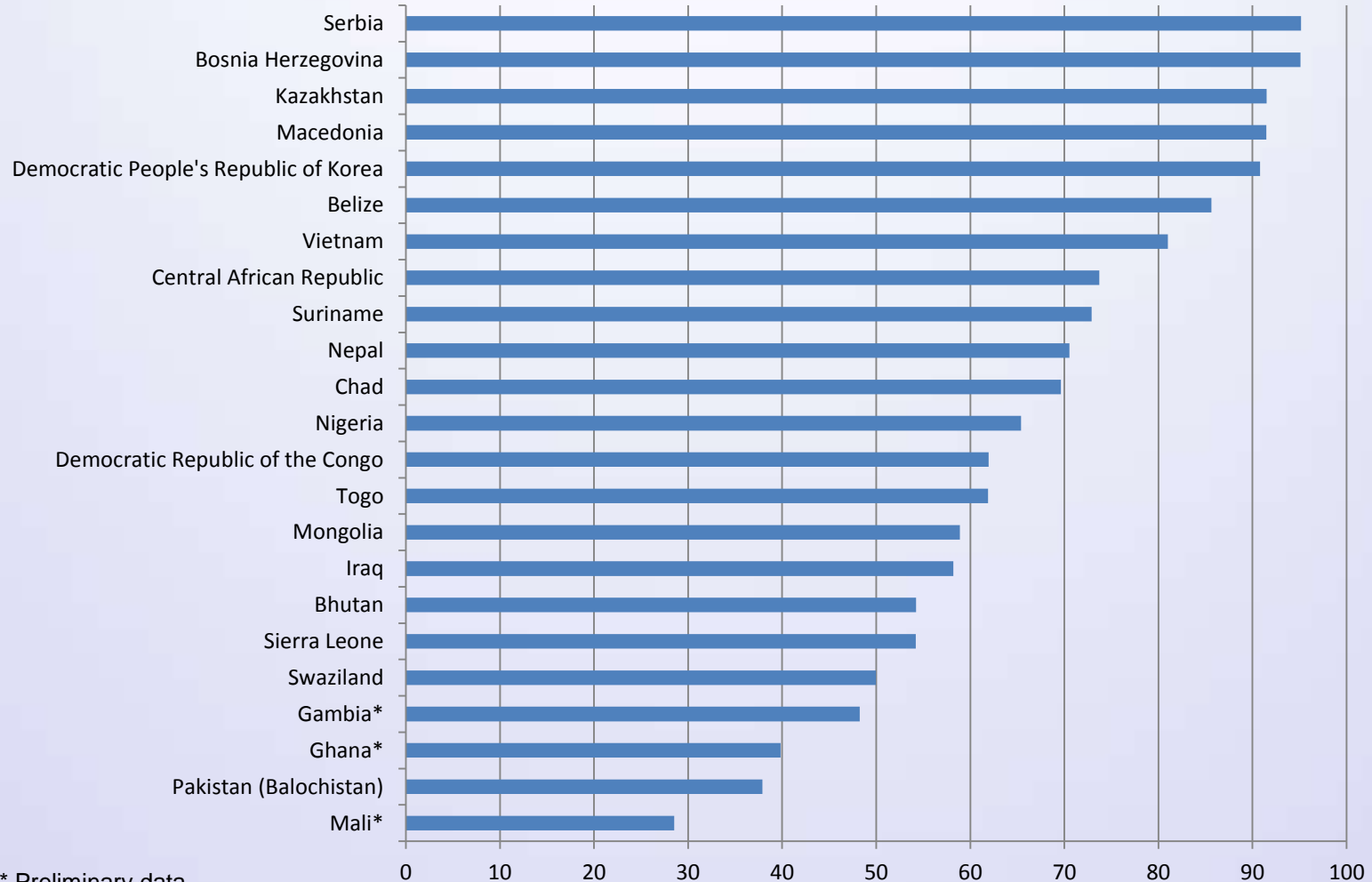

Adult Support for Learning

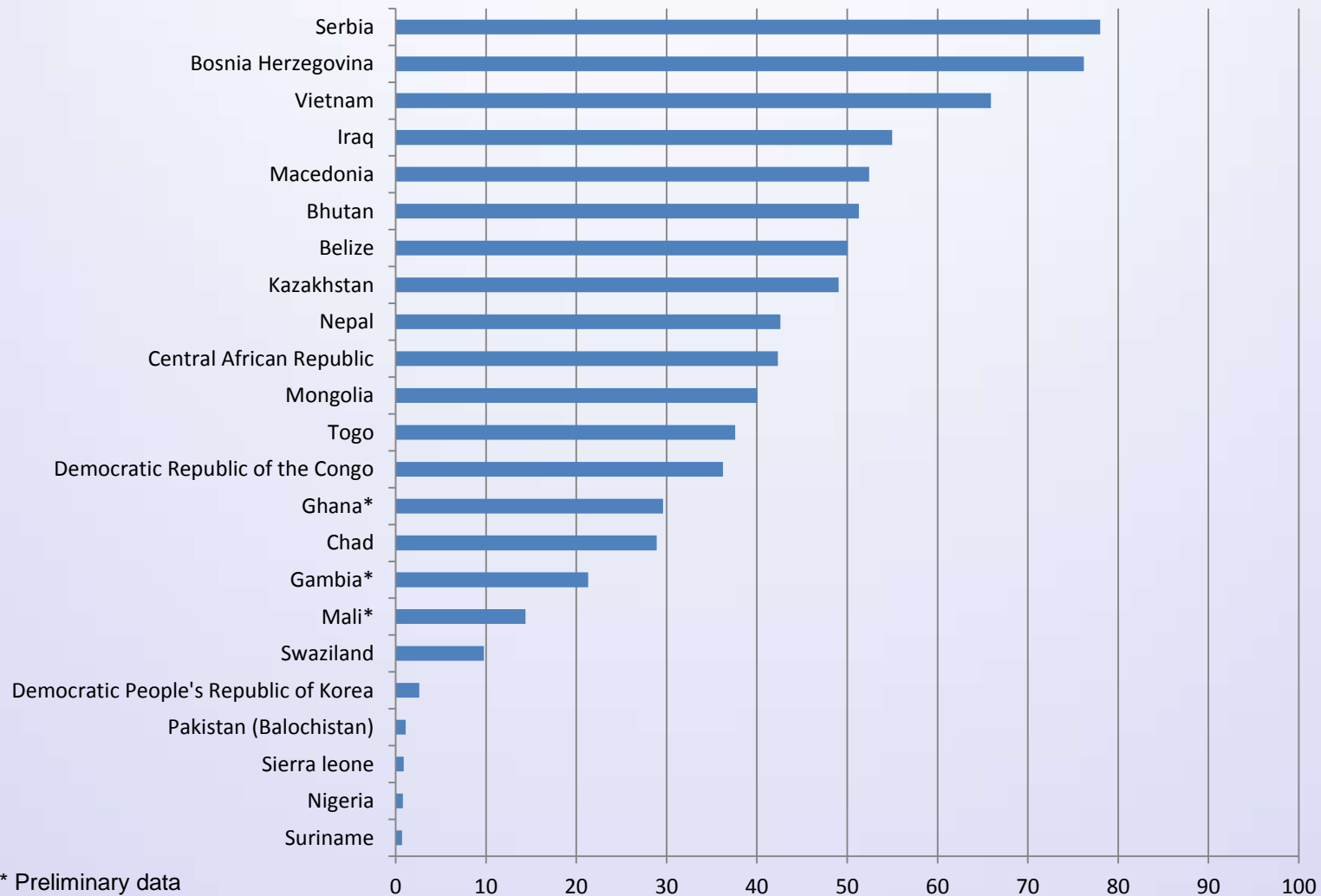

Father's Support for Learning

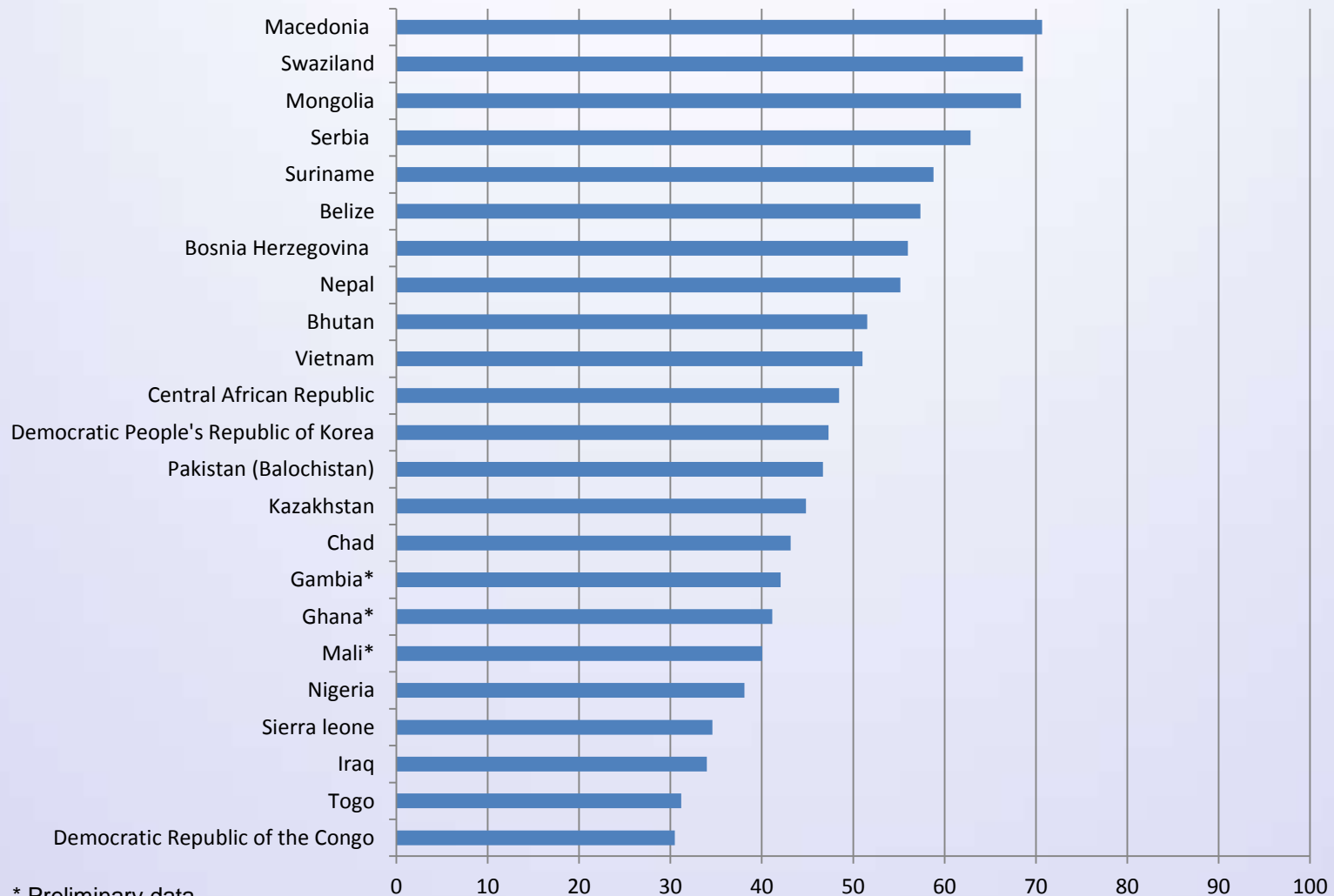

Availability of Playthings



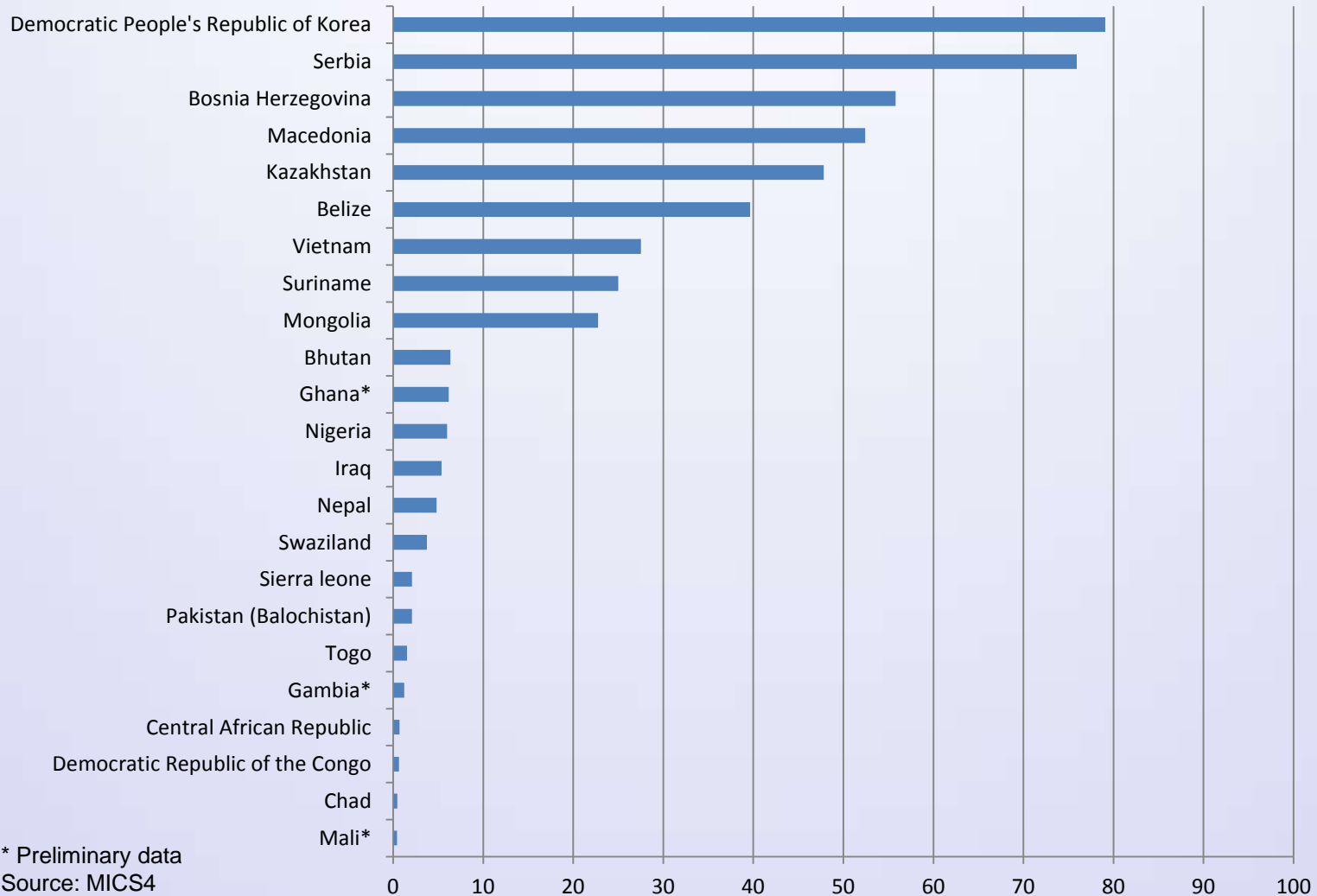

Availability of Books



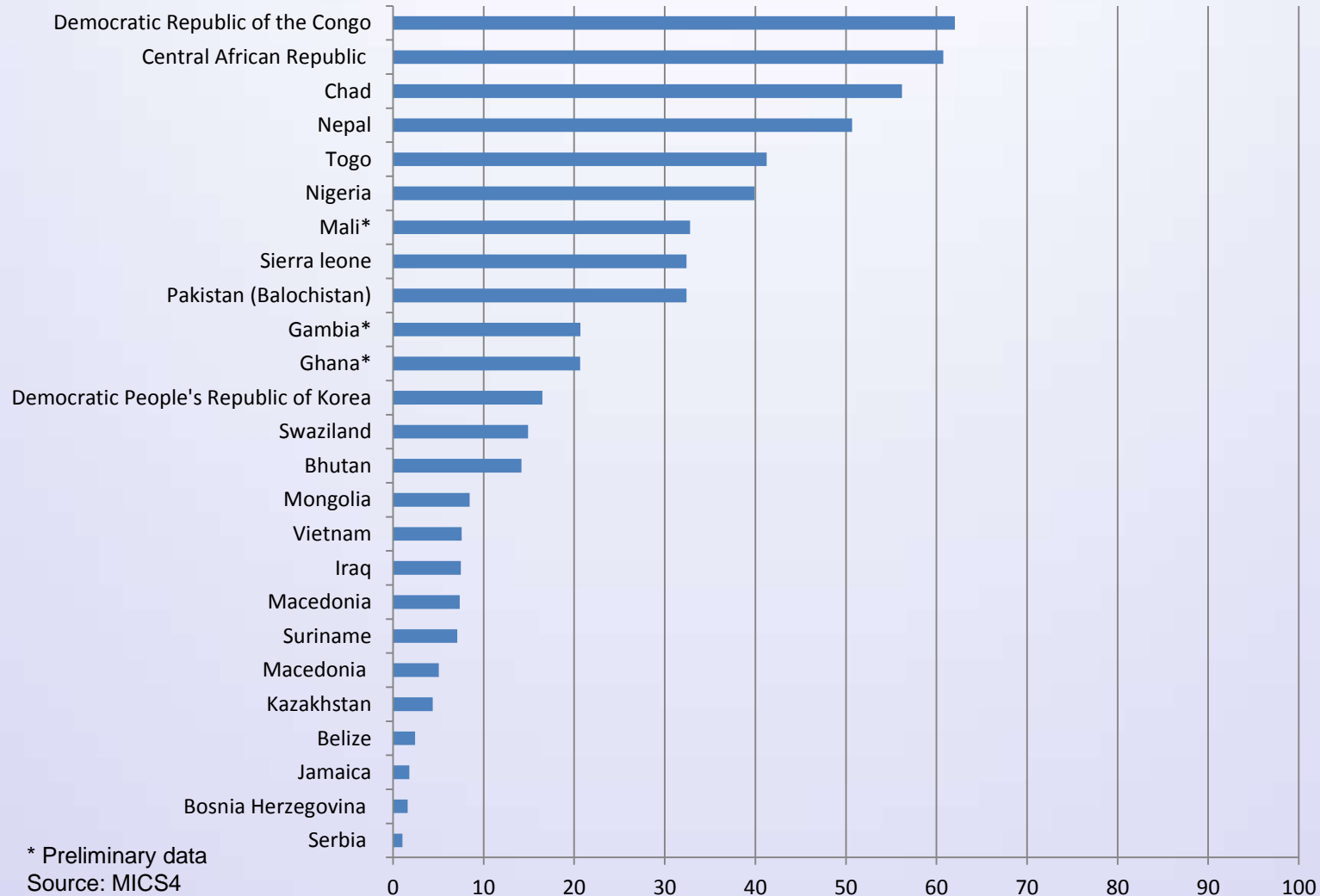

Inadequate Care

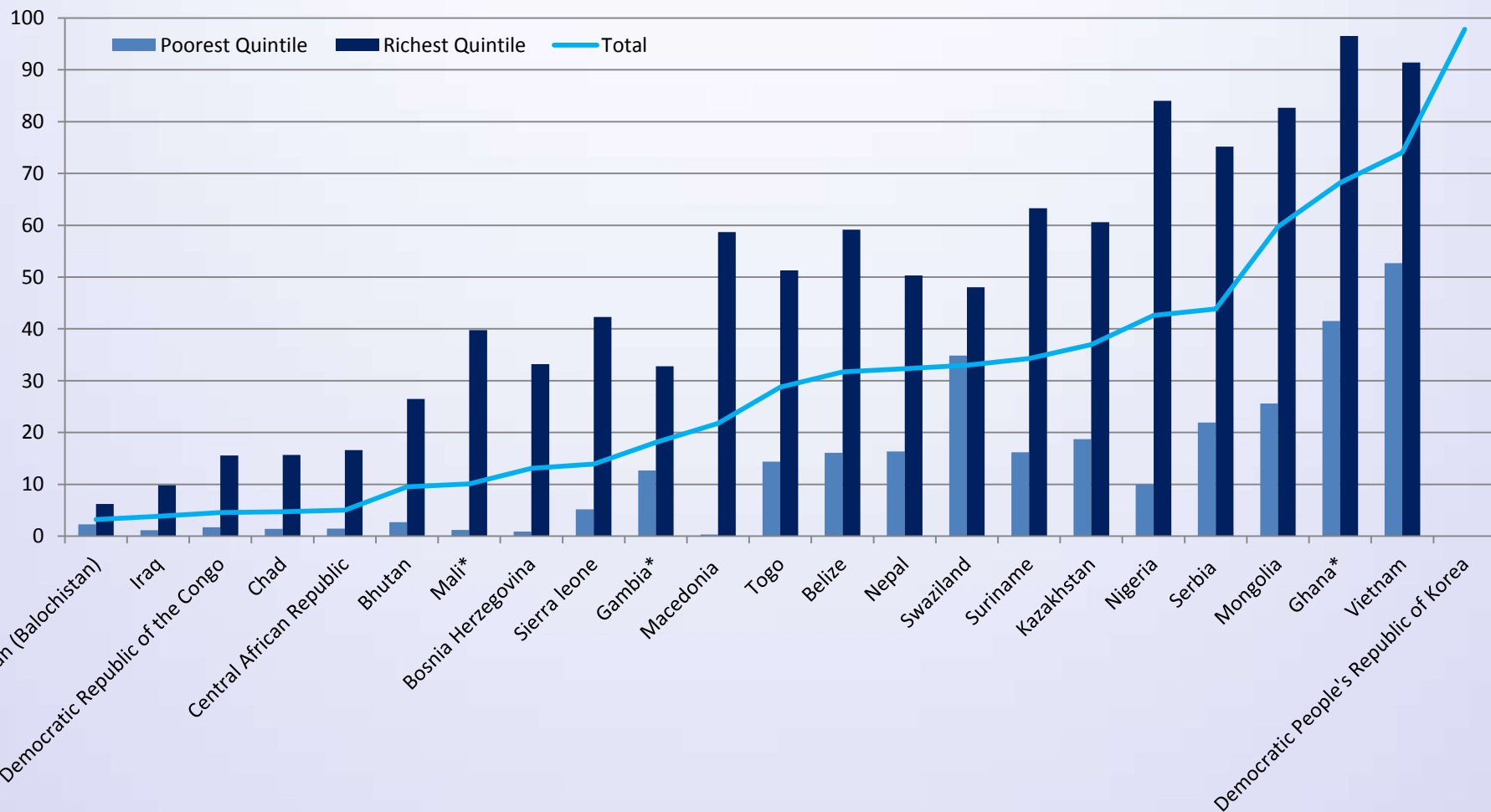
