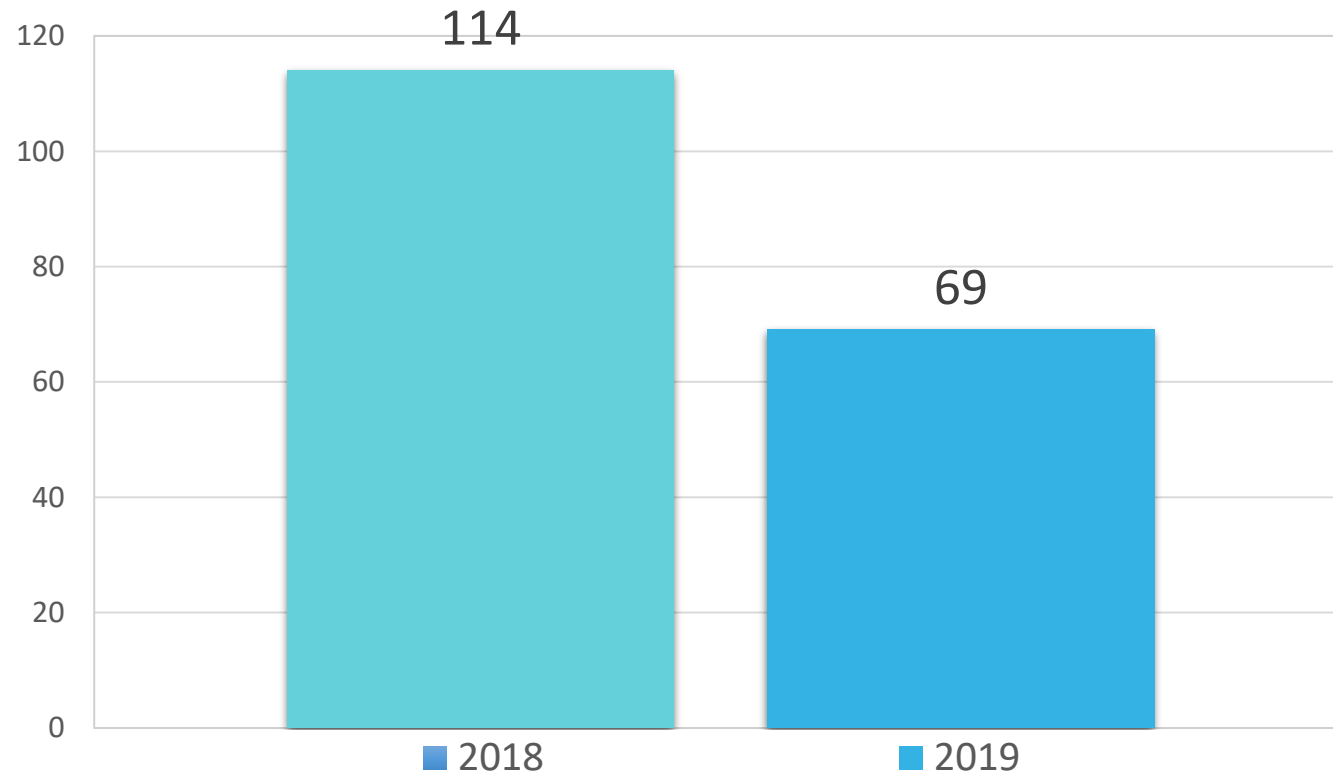

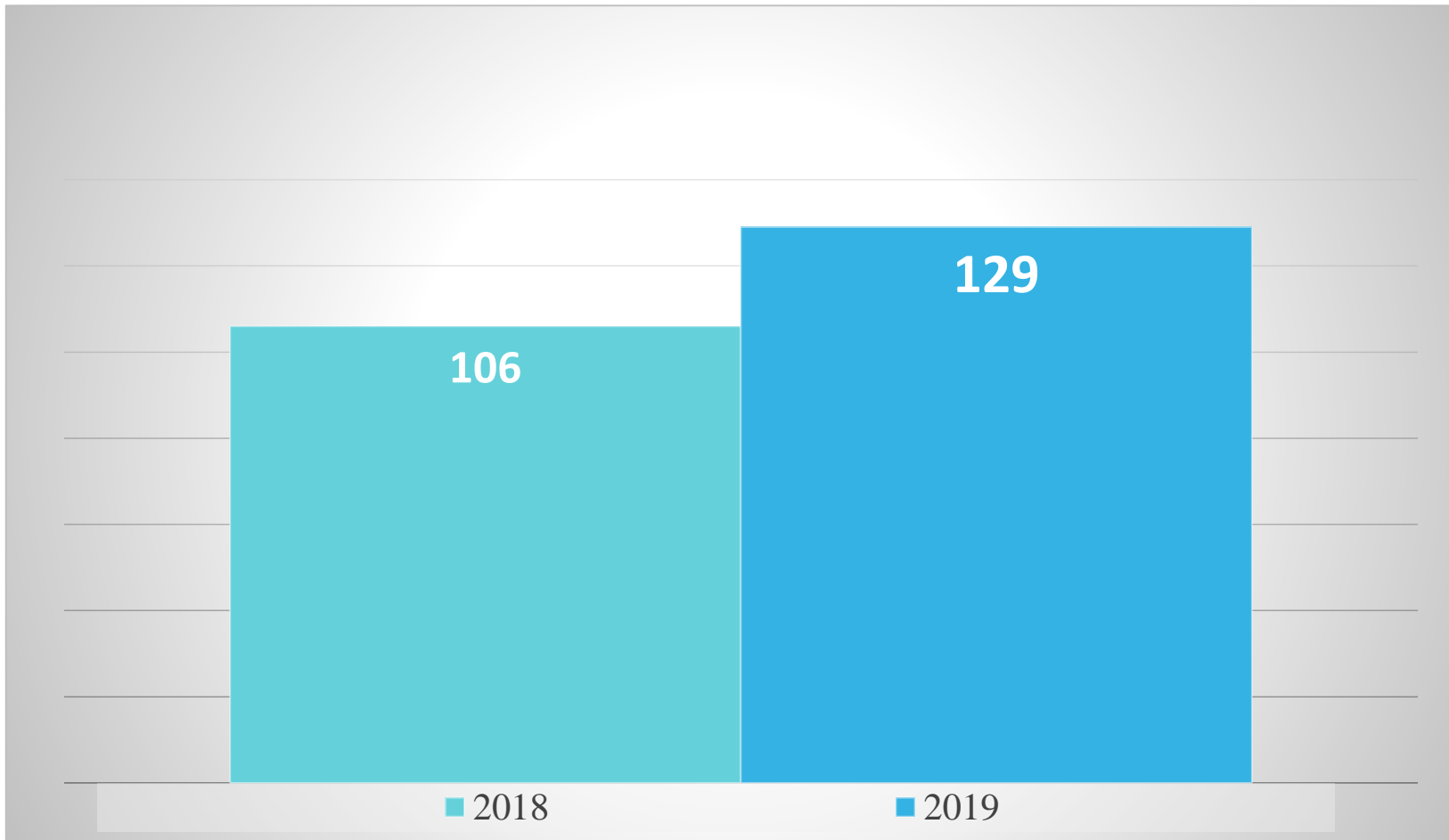
Comparative statistics on children placed to SEUI in the period of September-December of 2018 and of 2019

RESULTS RELATED TO REHABILITATION

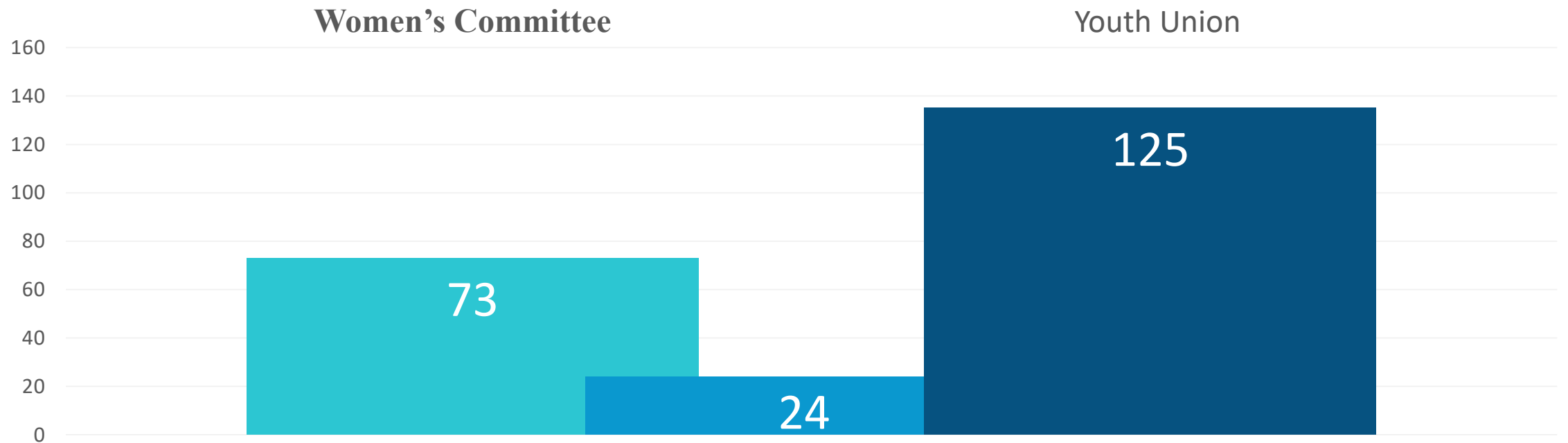
Number of children released from SEUI in the period of September-December of 2018 and of 2019

RESULTS RELATED TO REINTEGRATION

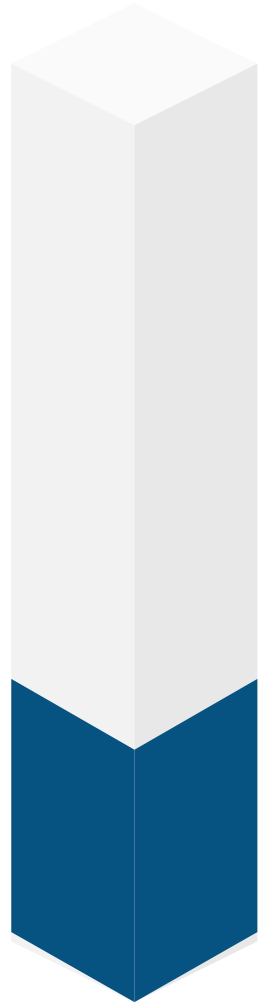
Measure taken by the Women's Committee and the Youth Union

■ Number of children (girls) employed in September-December 2019

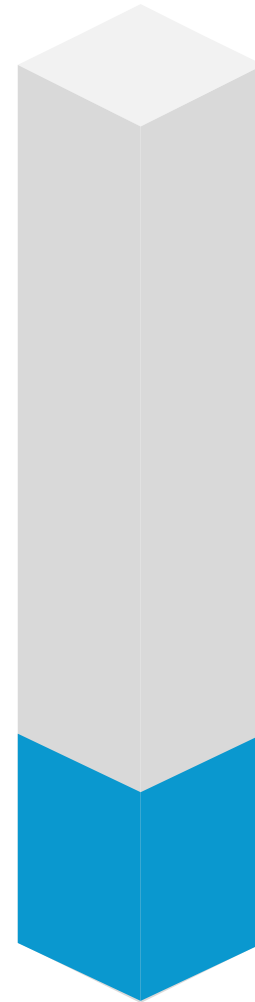
■ Number of children returned from SEUI in September-December 2019 to whom a mentor from the Youth Union was assigned



IN 2019

The number of children committed crimes reduced to **25,6 %** in comparison with 2018
(in 2018 – 1100 children , in 2019 – 818 children)

IN 2019

The number of crimes, committed by children reduced to almost **20 %** in comparison with 2018
(in 2018– 923 crimes, in 2019– 739 crimes)
