GOLDEN ADVISORS

- Ombudsman has established the Golden Advisers' Network in 2014, composed of children from different parts of Montenegro
- The aim of the Network is to give the opportunity to children to participate in the work of the Ombudsperson through direct communication with the Institution
- The Network initially included 12 members aged 11 to 17 years and later it has expanded to 24 children/members
- Due regard was taken to gender representation and involvement of children belonging to vulnerable groups

The way Golden Advisers contribute to the work of the Institution:

- By putting ideas, proposals, suggestions
- Participating in an open debates on children's rights and position of children in Montenegrin society
- Promoting children's rights and the work of the Ombudsperson in their schools and local communities
- Preparation of the special Report to CRC Committee on the situation of CR in Montenegro, presented at the CRC pre-session in Geneva and national Parliament consequently
