

# Refugee and migrant children in Greece

As of 28 February 2018



## Key figures

**21,000** estimated number of refugee and migrant children across Greece. Among them **3,030 UAC**

**79** accompanied children have been returned to Turkey, in the framework of the EU- Turkey statement (20 March 2016- 28 February 2018)

**420** children received international protection in Greece on first instance during February. Among them **30 UAC** (February 2018)

Out of 3,030 estimated number of UAC in Greece, more than **1,912** children (including those living in safe zones and hotels) are still in need of shelter for unaccompanied children, including **58** UAC in protective custody




More than **2,700** children living in urban areas (apartments and shelters for unaccompanied children) are estimated to have enrolled in Greek schools, as of beginning of 2018 (source: MoE)

This amounts for **55%** of the of children 5-17 years old residing in apartments with their families or shelters for unaccompanied children

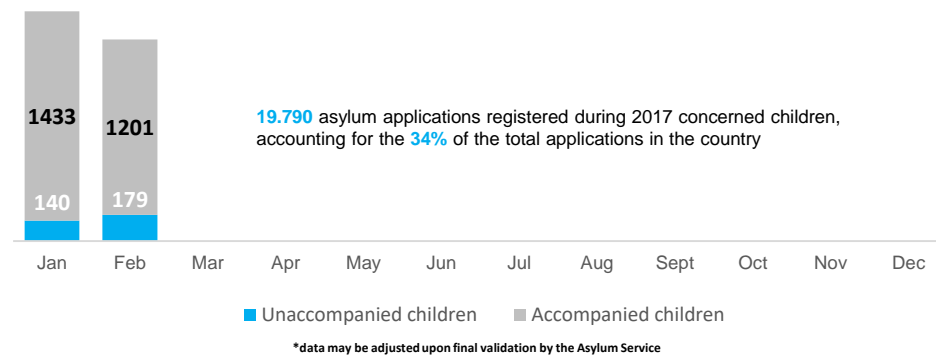


Additionally, **1,822** children **6-17 years old** residing in open accommodation sites are regularly attending morning or afternoon classes and **400** children 5-6 years old are enrolled in kindergartens (source: MoE)

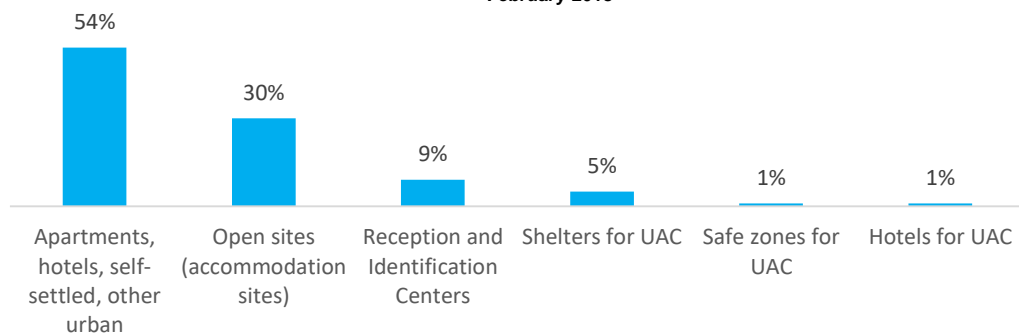


**12,000** estimated number of school-age children. **38%** of them are estimated to be enrolled in Greek schools
