Lessons learned including the need to involve traditional and grassroots elements, and a review of the training approach have the potential to lead to greater effectiveness and impact.</li><li data-bbox="586 1052 1377 1136">• To flag (and noted in the report) that access to the Breakaway Territories (South Ossetia and Abkhazia) will impact on the UNICEF's ability to deliver.</li><li data-bbox="586 1184 1377 1444">• There is no indication about links, relationships and synergies between the CPD and the current work on Women, Peace and Security (WPS) Agenda, women empowerment and participation, and gender-based violence (GBV) in Georgia. We recommend UNICEF explore the potential for synergies on the ground, particularly in Georgia's conflict-affected areas and communities where an overlap of work on WPS, GBV, etc. and UNICEF scope is likely.</li></ul>
