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Note on the draft country programme document for Cameroon (E/ICEF/2026/P/L.25)

The Secretary of the Executive Board has been informed by UNICEF of the following updates that will be made to the draft country programme document (CPD) dated 8 June 2026. These corrections will be reflected in the final CPD that will be made available to the Executive Board six weeks ahead of the second regular session of 2026, and in the other designated languages four weeks ahead of the session, in accordance with established practice.
