Lack of access to **education, skills development and participation** of children and adolescents.

**Child poverty and inequality**

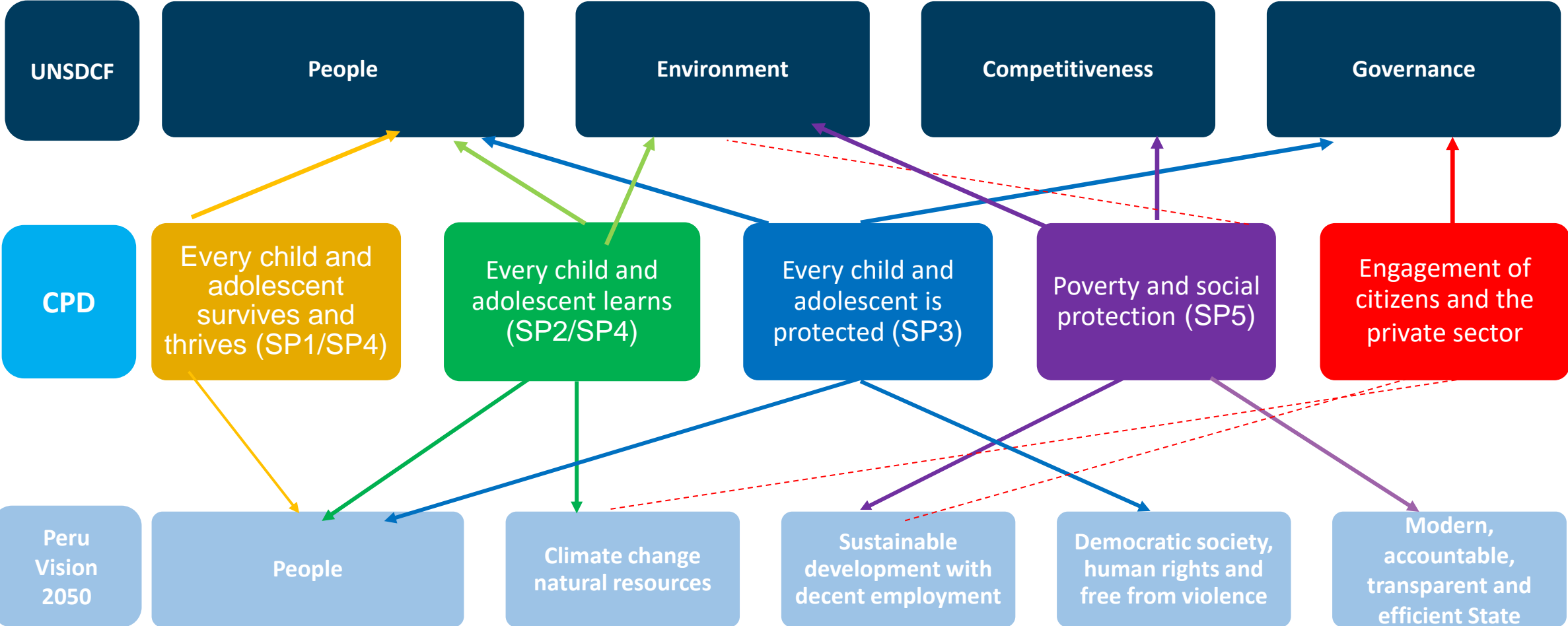
Poverty and inequalities continue to have an impact on children and adolescents, especially indigenous and migrant children and children with disabilities.

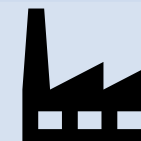

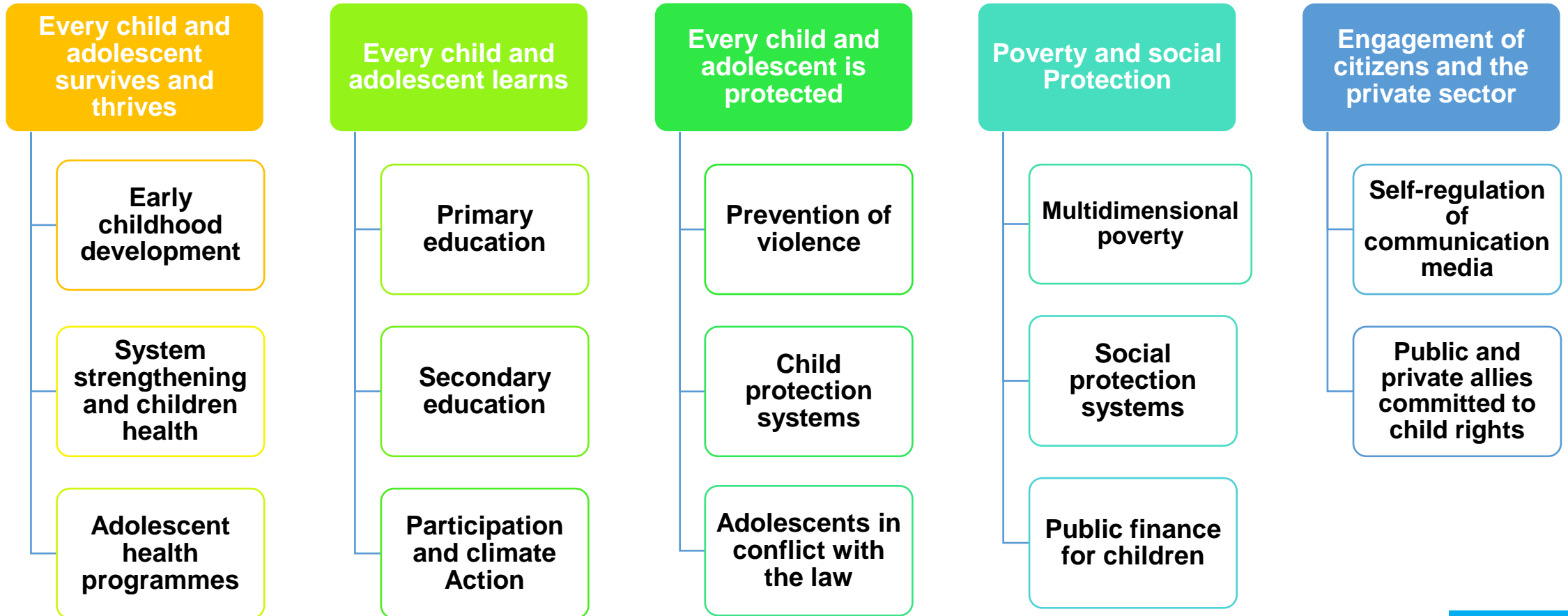
