In accordance with the rotation scheme established by the Executive Board in its decision 1992/7 (document [E/ICEF/1992/14](#)), the President for 2017 will be nominated from among the Latin American and Caribbean States that are members of the Executive Board. The election will take place on 10 January 2017.
