

2023 KEY RESULTS FOR CHILDREN

This year, UNICEF Indonesia worked with a wide range of government and civil society partners to create a better world for Indonesia's children.

6.1 million children were vaccinated against polio and 4 new vaccines introduced nationwide with UNICEF advocacy and technical assistance

44 million internet users were reached with useful information and resources for the prevention of online child sexual exploitation and abuse through #JagaBareng campaign launched in February

4.5 million people newly gained access to sanitation, bringing the number of people living in areas declared open defecation free, with UNICEF support, to 51 million





Over 1 million young people joined the U-Report platform, engaging in discussions on topics like climate change and online safety



Mitra Muda climate activists elevated the voice of young Indonesians on climate change at COP28, while 1,300 young people received coaching and seed funding support to take action



Analysis of government spending for children conducted in 7 sectors at national level and in 5 provinces, with training and peer learning among districts on prioritizing and tracking budgets for child-related services

First ever 'Landscape Analysis on Children with Disabilities in Indonesia', led by Bappenas, shed light on deprivations facing children with disabilities and pathways to disability-inclusive development that leaves no child behind

UNICEF's engagement led to 40 districts investing in the education needs of out-of-school children and those at risk of dropping out, including 9 districts starting this year

Over 5 million adolescent girls received iron and folic acid supplements to prevent anaemia through the Aksi Bergizi school nutrition programme, supported by UNICEF and being scaled-up by the Government



Publication 'Islamic Perspective on Protecting Children from Violence and Harmful Practices' issued in consultation with 20 Islamic universities in Indonesia
