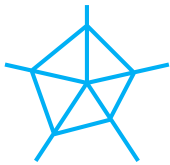

Overview

WHAT IS THE 5D INNOVATION FRAMEWORK?

The 5D Innovation Framework supports the identification, validation, and scaling of innovation solutions.

The framework allows for the identification, validation, and scaling of potentially transformative innovative ideas and solutions aligned with UNICEF's mission. It provides structure to systematically generate evidence and capture crucial data and insights throughout the scaling process.

It provides the foundation to help decision-makers make strategic choices, increasing the likelihood of successful scaling and, equally critically, provides an objective basis for rejecting an innovation or discontinuing support to it.

The 5D Innovation Framework considers that scaling a solution involves a multidimensional approach, and each dimension (innovation, business model, impact, scalability, and risk) plays a crucial role in the scaling journey. The 18 sub-components along five dimensions offer insights into different aspects of what it takes to scale.



Innovation: Determines whether a solution is innovative. i.e. solves a key problem, is truly 'new or significantly improved', and adds significant value over what exists already.



Business Model: Assesses the business model to ensure that the innovation is financially sustainable and primed for long-term success.



Scalability: Assesses the solutions' scalability to ensure that there is the innovation is adaptable, is aligned with UNICEF and government priorities, has a specialized team, and has created appropriate deployment resources.

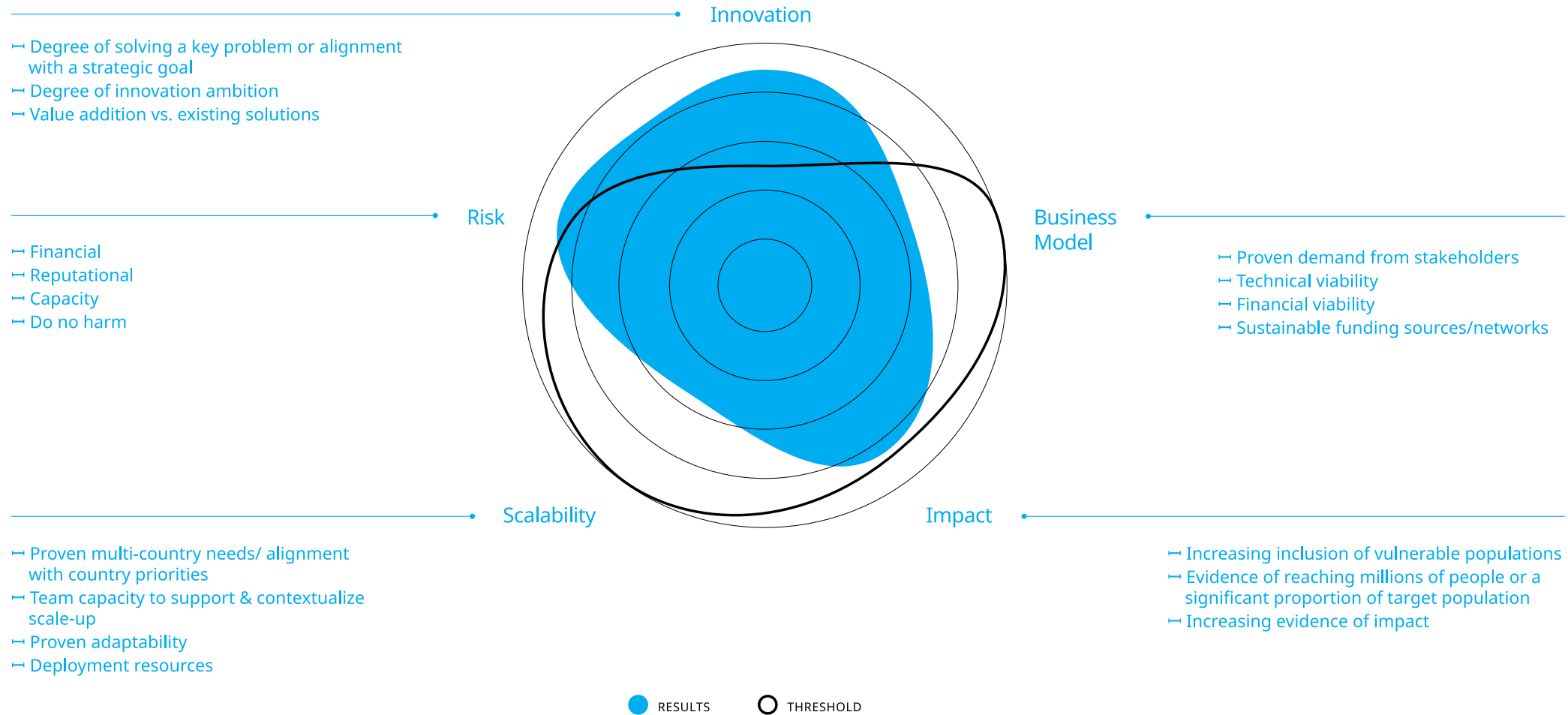


Impact: Assesses whether the solution has evidence of impact contributing to equity and reaching millions of children or a significant proportion of the target population



Risk: Mitigates potential risks and setbacks in the scaling journey and offers mitigation strategies. Four risk types are considered: financial, reputational, capacity, and do-no-harm.

UNICEF'S 5D INNOVATION FRAMEWORK



The **5D Web Assessment** is a set of online tools to easily assess and review the results of initiatives against the 5D Framework. It consists of two resources.

Users will receive an autogenerated email with the results of their submission, along with a quick visual representation.



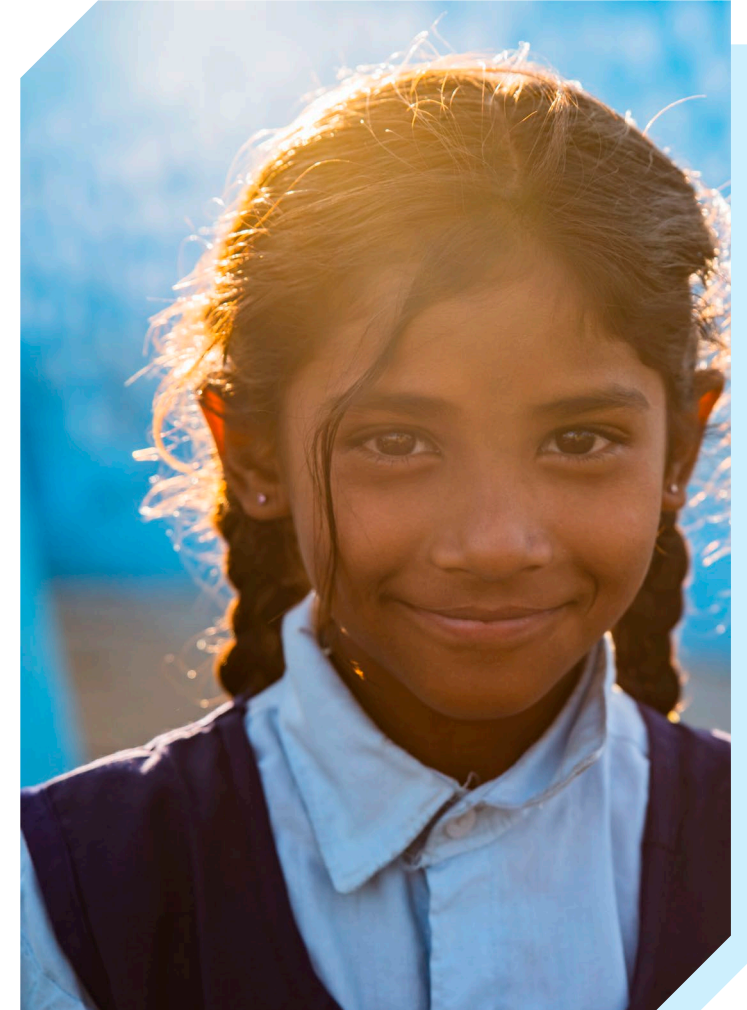
