## HEALTH & NUTRITION

**\$9,235,000**



**15** of impacted Primary Health Care Centres (PHC) and dispensaries rehabilitated, provided with emergency supplies and minimum initial service package  
**10,000** children vaccinated each month in the PHCs located in area of explosion

**55,000** children under five receive essential nutrition supplements including Vitamin A  
**6,000** caregivers of children 0-23 months receive counselling and guidance on Infant and Young Child Feeding

**80,000** vulnerable children and individuals receive emergency cash transfers

## WATER AND SANITATION

**\$16,259,747**



**50,000** affected people assisted with temporary access to adequate quantity of safe water for drinking and domestic use

## EDUCATION

**50,000** school children receive educational supplies

**4,000** youth access employment or income generation opportunities through rehabilitation, construction and other means

## CHILD PROTECTION

**25,000** children, parents and primary caregivers provided with community-based mental health and psycho-social support  
**1,000** girls and women provided with psycho-social first aid, psycho-social support and information on gender-based violence risks
