

Over the past 15 years, the mortality rate of children under five has steadily declined from 72 per thousand in 2006 to 59 per thousand in 2016

Every hour, 6 children die before reaching their fifth birthday, including 2 children



Every second birth is assisted by a skilled health personnel. A significant discrepancy is observed between urban (72%) and rural (40%)



Stunting refers to a child who is too short for his or her age. Stunting is the failure to grow

both physically and cognitively and is the

result of chronic or recurrent malnutrition.



Foundational numeracy skills:

successfully completes 1) a number reading task, 2) a number discrimination task, 3) an addition task, and 4) a pattern recognition

Wasting refers to a child who is too thin for his or her

height. Wasting, or acute malnutrition, is the result of recent rapid weight loss or the failure to gain weight.

A child who is moderately or severely wasted has an

increased risk of death, but treatment is possible.


