



Countries covered under UNICEF response









They also offer referral services for women, including for support on gender-based violence.

Operational and planned Blue Dots as of May 27 2022

Prior to the emergency, UNICEF had country programmes and offices in 4 countries engaged in the current refugee response, with a total of 106 regular staff members.



Currently, UNICEF has 99 surge staff supporting the refugee response across 8 countries and UNICEF's Regional Office (ECARO), including 4 countries without previous UNICEF programme and country office presence.
