Floods and Landslides in  
Chittagong and Cox's Bazar

5<sup>th</sup> September 2023

### Highlights

- Since August 5, 2023, continuous monsoon rains have affected Chattogram, Cox's Bazar, Rangamati, and Bandarban in Bangladesh. **1.3 million people** including **630,000 women and 480,000 children** (0-18 years old) are affected and **600,000 people** are in need in four districts (Chattogram, Cox's Bazar, Rangamati, and Bandarban), **with 51 deaths** reported<sup>1</sup>.
- In Cox's Bazar, approximately **538,373 people (including 25,533 in Rohingya camps and 185,200 children)** are exposed after the floods and landslides, while nearly **85,500 people (3,500 children and 3,974 Rohingya refugees)** were displaced and sheltered in temporary flood shelters<sup>2</sup>.
- Multi-sectoral contingency partnership with Green Hill has been activated for the flash floods response in Chittagong. WASH, Education and SBC Sectors target up to 63,500 beneficiaries in the response.
- With UNICEF support, distribution of 3,000 Hygiene kit boxes (each box contains 15 items) for Chandanisae and Satkania Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE) under Chattogram district is in progress which will benefit **13,500 beneficiaries**.
- More than **87,050 children (50,200 female, 351 Children with disabilities)** and community members were reached with critical information and services such as sporting events and hub activities via the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs (MoWCA) and MoYS outreaches.
- In Cox's Bazar, with UNICEF support, approximately 10,000 Rohingya refugees (approximately 4,700 children and 5,500 women) and more than 120,000 people in the host communities (approximately 55,600 children and 56,900 women) have received WASH supports including handwashing device, tubewell and latrine repair, disinfection of water and sanitation infrastructures as well as aqua tabs.
- However, critical funding gaps across all sectors are still present, with a HAC funding gap of **US\$60.6M (35% per cent)** restricting UNICEF's ability to meet the priority needs of girls, women, and persons with disabilities.

## Humanitarian Situation and Needs<sup>3</sup>

The Chattogram Division is grappling with devastating flash floods that have left thousands marooned without essential provisions like food, clean water, medicine, and electricity. Since August 5, 2023, continuous monsoon rains have affected Chattogram, Cox's Bazar, Rangamati, and Bandarban in Bangladesh. Heavy rainfall, ranging from 44 to 89 mm, led to flash floods and landslides in the Hill Tracts, especially in Bandarban town and nearby areas. **1.3 million people including 630,000 women and 480,000 children (0-19 years old) are affected while 600,000 people are in need of humanitarian assistance** in four districts (Chattogram, Cox's Bazar, Rangamati, and Bandarban), with 51 deaths reported<sup>1</sup>.

38 out of the division's 51 Upazilas are submerged, leading to significant destruction in Chattogram, Cox's Bazar, Rangamati, and Bandarban. Major rivers in the region were overflowing, crippling major transport routes, and resulting in the damage of up to 410 kilometres of roads. Immediate efforts have been channeled towards rescue operations, relief distributions, and addressing the basic requirements of the affected people. The persisting issue of landslides demands urgent attention. A comprehensive long-term plan to reduce climate related risks are urgently needed.

## Chittagong (Bandarban, Rangamati, Chattogram and Khagrachari Districts)

**Chattogram District:** A total of **843,505 people (401,959 female, 292,214 children including 7,013 CAwD<sup>4</sup>)** have been affected by the flash floods and landslides in Chattogram City and 15 Upazilas (sub-districts) of Chattogram District, with Chandanaisa, Satkania, and Lohagara Upazilas severely affected.<sup>5</sup> A total of 28,070 houses were damaged, 18,885 partially and 9,185 houses fully damaged. The District Administration reported 16 deaths including 1 child.

**Bandarban District:** **62,000 people (23,677 female, 13,680 children including 589 CAwD<sup>5</sup>)** have been impacted by the flashfloods and landslides in over 7 Upazilas. 6,579 houses have been damaged (5,173 partially damaged and 1,406 fully damaged). 108 para-centers have been destroyed. 10 people died due to landslides and drowning, while 4 others were injured. Currently 396 people are living in shelters.

**Rangamati District:** **30,254 people (8,954 female and 11,981 children including 161 CAwD)** from 8,425 households located in 29 unions of 7 Upazilas and Rangamati Municipality are affected. Five deaths were reported, 4 of them children.<sup>5</sup> The Director of Primary Education (DPE) reported that 71 Primary schools were damaged partially while the SSS CHT management reported 40 Para-centers being damaged. Overall, the flood situation is improving though the affected communities are yet to recover from their losses.

**Khagrachari District:** **15,000 people (4,439 female, 5,940 children)** were affected in Khagrachari District. The situation in Khagrachari has gradually improved.

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## UNICEF Response

### Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH)

- Distribution of 3,000 Hygiene kit boxes (each box contains 15 items) supported by UNICEF for Chandanaisa and Satkania DPHE under Chattogram district is in progress with up to **13,500 beneficiaries to benefit**.
- With UNICEF support, construction of 100 climate resilient sanitary toilets with disability-friendly design is underway at Bandarban and Rangamati districts and will benefit an estimated 4,500 people.
- Hygiene promotion sessions were conducted on hand washing with soap and on Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM) through mass media and focused group discussions which reached approximately **1,350 people**.

## Nutrition

- With UNICEF support, Nutrition National Service (NNS) department in Dhaka allocated additional supplies (a total 18 items such as IEC materials, registers, monitoring tools, reporting formats, flow charts etc.) to all SAM units of Chattogram, Bandarban and Rangamati districts for smooth inpatient management of SAM children and reporting from the facilities.
- With UNICEF support and facilitation, the DRS in Chattogram received therapeutic milk (F-75 in 192 cans and F-100 in 120 cans) from the CMSD, Dhaka on 23 August 2023 for the management of SAM children in targeted health facilities. These supplies are only for **100 SAM children** with severe acute malnutrition who are admitted in health facilities (Upazila Health Complexes/hospitals).
- UNICEF followed up with district and Upazila level managers and service providers to strengthen nutrition service delivery at IMCI-N corners and in community clinics with a focus on MUAC screening, admission, and inpatient SAM management.
- UNICEF maintained coordination and updated the national level Nutrition Cluster on the situation, needs/gaps and recommendations. Also, UNICEF facilitated a Coordination meeting with the Divisional Director-Health and the Civil Surgeons of the flood affected districts (Cox's Bazar, Bandarban, Rangamati and Chattogram).

## Child Protection

- With UNICEF support and in partnership with the Department of Social Services (DSS), the list of vulnerable children and affected families in need has been finalized and a total of 2,850 Family kits and dignity kits was distributed to five affected districts (Bandarban, Chattogram, Rangamati, Khagrachari, and CXB) that will benefit the 2,850 households.
- Child Protection Section facilitated more than 2,650 information sessions (including information on how to seek help, drowning prevention and dengue prevention), and supported referral of vulnerable children for multi-sectoral services identified through the Child Protection Community Hubs in floods-affected locations and through the Child Helpline (CHL) 1098 (928 calls were related to information seeking). More than **87,050 (50,200 female, 351 children with disabilities)** children and community members were reached with critical information and services such as sporting events and hub activities via MoWCA and MoYS outreaches.
- Following a quick assessment, **16 additional Social Workers** have been deployed along with four Social Work Consultants for Child protection response work.
- With UNICEF support, case follow-up of the children in affected areas and provision of psychosocial support are ongoing facilitated by the social workers, reaching more than **2,500 beneficiaries (1,586 female, 76 people with disabilities)**.

## Health

- UNICEF has provided technical and financial support to conduct an intensive program in 10 upazilas by Health workers from the Government of Bangladesh who are conducting door to door visits to vaccinate the children as per eligible antigens in their respective affected areas. Up to now the coverage is BCG - 281, Penta1- 265, Penta 2- 273. Penta 3- 169, MR 1- 144 and MR 2- 147 doses.

## Education

- Together with the District and Divisional Education Authorities, UNICEF identified 127 damaged Government Primary Schools in Bandarban District and 198 damaged in Rangamati District and shared this information with the Directorate of Primary Education (DPE). The DPE will instruct schools to use the School Level Improvement Plans for repairs and to be complemented by 1,200 Education in Emergency (EiE) kits prepositioned in the UNICEF warehouse which will be distributed to children in 198 schools.
- Learning centers in Lama and Alikadam under The Educate the Most Disadvantaged Children (EMDC) projects supported by UNICEF have been damaged. A total of 14 learning centers needs to be renovated and relocated. Children need basic learning materials so that learners can start to learn quickly. The implementing partner is prioritizing renovation of the affected centers, and Project Officers and facilitators are visiting the children's homes to provide psychosocial support.

## Social and Behavior Change (SBC)

- UNICEF supported the District Information offices to identify the most affected areas for community engagement and message dissemination.
- UNICEF and partners disseminated key lifesaving messages and information among **318,000 affected population**

- through street miking.
- UNICEF provided lifesaving messages to 95,000 people (52,250 women) through the local radio station, Sagorgiri, which are continuously being aired by the radio station.

## Cox's Bazar

### Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH)

- With UNICEF support, **278 latrines, 98 bathing cubicles, 26 tube wells, 3 tap-stands, 3 transfer stations and 4 Solid Waste Management sites** were repaired. **14 latrines, 5 Bathing cubicles and 1 tube well** were decommissioned (their services discontinued due to contamination). **11 handwashing devices and 32 communal bins** have been installed so far along with **11 sites chlorinated, 21 water facilities and 86 sanitation facilities disinfected, with 118,400 aqua tabs distributed. As a result,** approximately 10,000 Rohingya refugees (approximately 4,700 children and 5,500 women) and more than 120,000 people in the host communities (approximately 55,600 children and 56,900 women) have received WASH supports.
- In the host communities, **5 tube wells, 1 tap stand, 610 latrines and 1011 handwashing devices** were repaired and installed, **235 water infrastructures disinfected and 21,510 aqua tabs distributed.** The WASH Section plans to distribute **1,900 Hygiene** kits among the most vulnerable flood- affected poor families in two of the most affected Upazilas.
- In collaboration with the WASH Section, **1,900 flood affected families** will be reached with hygiene kits (local) as part of our response.

### Child Protection

- With UNICEF support, **60 children (30 girls)** from the refugee camps, and **2 boys** from the host community were relocated to a more secure environment to ensure their safety.
- Members of the Community-based Child Protection Committee (CBCPC) and staff are actively disseminating messages on the impact of the monsoon, Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) strategies, as well as crucial Child Protection (CP) and Gender-Based Violence (GBV) risks. So far, these activities have reached approximately 3,502 community members including 1,807 females. Additionally, CBCPCs are playing a vital role in spreading awareness on dengue prevention, emergency shelter locations, the importance of preserving essential documents, and the post-disaster impact.
- Psychosocial Support (PSS) has been extended to **203 children** and adolescents **including 98 girls and 15 children with disabilities. 8 children (3 girls)** from the host community have also received Psychosocial First Aid (PFA) in the camps.
- Furthermore, case management support has been provided to **34 children (18 girls and nine children with disabilities).**

### Health

- In the host communities, during the floods, a Rickshaw Van was utilized to transfer patients to the Pekua and Chakaria health complexes as access roads to the hospitals and court yards were flooded.
- Two Mobile Medical Teams are prepared to deploy within the catchment area to provide emergency health support. The health teams are fully functional at their respective health facilities and ready for future emergencies. Health teams will continue to liaise with the CIC Office and Site Management for emergency health support as needed.

### Nutrition & Humanitarian Cash Transfer (HCT)

- In the host communities, **1,006 women-headed most vulnerable**, and flood affected families (including women-headed families with person with disabilities) have been identified and will be supported with unconditional multi-purpose cash grant (aligned to the Cash Working Group guideline). This multipurpose grant has been implemented through the Nutrition Program which already runs a similar intervention for vulnerable families, and will support the affected families to cope with the post-flood situation and partially recover from the devastation of the flooding.
- In the Rohingya camps, at least 52 Mobile Nutrition Team (MNT) are on standby to give support in any kind of emergency and also sensitization is continuing within the community on maintaining safety during heavy rainfall. Regular communication with the site management sector team and Disaster Management Committees (DMCs) is maintained in the camp area to get updates about progress of the response.

## Humanitarian Coordination and Leadership

UNICEF's Chattogram Field Office is in regular contact and coordination with Government Departments to monitor the situation. UNICEF met with the Deputy Commissioner of Bandarban, the Chairman of the Bandarban Hill District Council (BHDC) and the secretary of the Ministry of Chittagong Hill Tracts Affairs (MoCHTA) to update the UNICEF response plan with other UN agencies (UNDP, UNFPA, WFP) and also organized a meeting with one implementing partner to discuss a contingency partnership in Rangamati. UNICEF advocated, through the chairman of Bandarban Hill District Council (BHDC), for the renovation of 108 damaged para centres in Bandarban. Moreover, UNICEF participated in a UN coordination meeting in Chattogram to discuss coordination and a multi-sectoral flood response. In Cox's Bazar, a Disaster Management Control Room was opened under the leadership of the Deputy Commissioner of Cox's Bazar district. Meetings of the Cox's Bazar District Disaster Management Committee (DDMC), and Health Coordination meeting were held on a regular basis from the week of 5 August 2023 to date. The Deputy Commissioner's office finalized the D-form and shared this with the Ministry of Disaster management and Relief (MoDMR) and the DRR Working Group of Cox's Bazar. UNICEF Field Office Teams are in regular contact with the sectoral focal points, the Office of The Refugee Relief and Repatriation (RRRC) and Deputy Commissioner's office as well as the Civil Surgeon's office and the Department of Public Health and Engineering (DPHE) and sharing relevant information. UNICEF is leading the WASH and Nutrition Clusters and Child Protection sub-sector as well as being the co-lead of the Education Sector. UNICEF is an active member of the Emergency Preparedness and Response Working Group and the Access Working Group (AWG). A meeting of the Access Working Group was held on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2023 to discuss the challenges of delivery to humanitarian access in the flood affected camps. The Resident Coordinator's Office is currently working on a Humanitarian Response Plan (August 2023-January 2024) for the floods repose.

## Funding Situation

By 6 September 2023, UNICEF Bangladesh Country Office had mobilized about US\$ 505,000 from the Danish Government as part of Thematic Humanitarian support for the dengue and flood response in Bangladesh. However, critical funding gaps in the UNICEF Bangladesh Country Office HAC 2023 across all sectors restricted UNICEF's ability to meet the priority needs of girls, women, and people with disabilities during the flooding. Flexible donor funding is crucial to provide essential support to flood-affected communities in the southeast of Bangladesh. The current funding status is shown below:
