Protection

- training of 650 Civilian Police of the African Union on child rights, child protection, and code of conduct pertaining to Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV)
- Due to UNICEF & Partners advocacy, survivors of the SGBV victims Darfur can now receive medical treatment without completing a police report which was required earlier and at times intimidating
- **Background:** strong implementation in South and West Darfur
- 369 child-friendly spaces for 172,000 children in 50 in all three Darfur states (including SLA areas)

Health & Nutrition

- Immunized 1.4 million under 5 against polio (98% coverage)
- 3.1 million children against measles
- malnutrition rates have dropped from 21.8% in 2004 to 11.9% by 2005.
- UNICEF supports 140 Feeding Programs (47 Therapeutic Feeding Centers and 93 Supplementary Feeding Centers). These facilities treat about 2,000 severely malnourished and about 10,000 moderately malnourished children each month).

WES

- 924,000 people with safe drinking water and 873,000 with sanitation facilities.

Education

- Supported 375,000 children to attend schools
- Assisted 63 communities to establish community Girls' schools
