In December 2020, the UNICEF Country Office in Montenegro and the European Union, represented by the Delegation of the European Union to Montenegro, entered into a Contribution Agreement (Ref. No. IPA/2020/421-932) with the aim of supporting implementation of a two-year action called ***Strengthening the health system's resilience and response to the COVID-19 pandemic and epidemiological risks***, which started on 11 January 2021.
