To mark World Day Against Child Labour, UNICEF, the Myanmar Literacy Resource Centre and the International Labour Organisation ran a workshop with children enrolled in Non-Formal Primary Education supported by the Quality Basic Education Programme (QBEP). The children learnt about child labour using the ILO's SCREAM methodology and drew pictures on the theme "No to Child Labour -- Yes to Quality Education".
