Page 12

The text that states “After a broad-based partnership set out to eradicate polio, **India was declared polio-free in 2012**, a mere three years after it had contributed to nearly half of the world’s polio cases” should now read:

In February 2012, India was removed from the WHO list of polio-endemic countries after completing one year without any cases. This came a mere three years after the country had contributed to nearly half of the world’s polio cases.

Page 1

The text under ‘January’ in “2012: A year of progress – a year of ‘firsts’” that states “**India is declared polio-free**, a mere three years after contributing to nearly half of the world’s cases of the disease” should now read:

India completes one year without any cases of polio. The country is removed from the World Health Organization’s list of polio-endemic countries in February.

Page 3

The text under ‘November’ in “2012: A year of progress – a year of firsts” that states “China is declared free of maternal and neonatal tetanus by the World Health Organization” should now read:

UNICEF welcomes a 30 October declaration by the World Health Organization that China has eliminated maternal and neonatal tetanus.
