children out of 55 UASC were reunified with their families in Upper Nile, Unity and NBeG States.

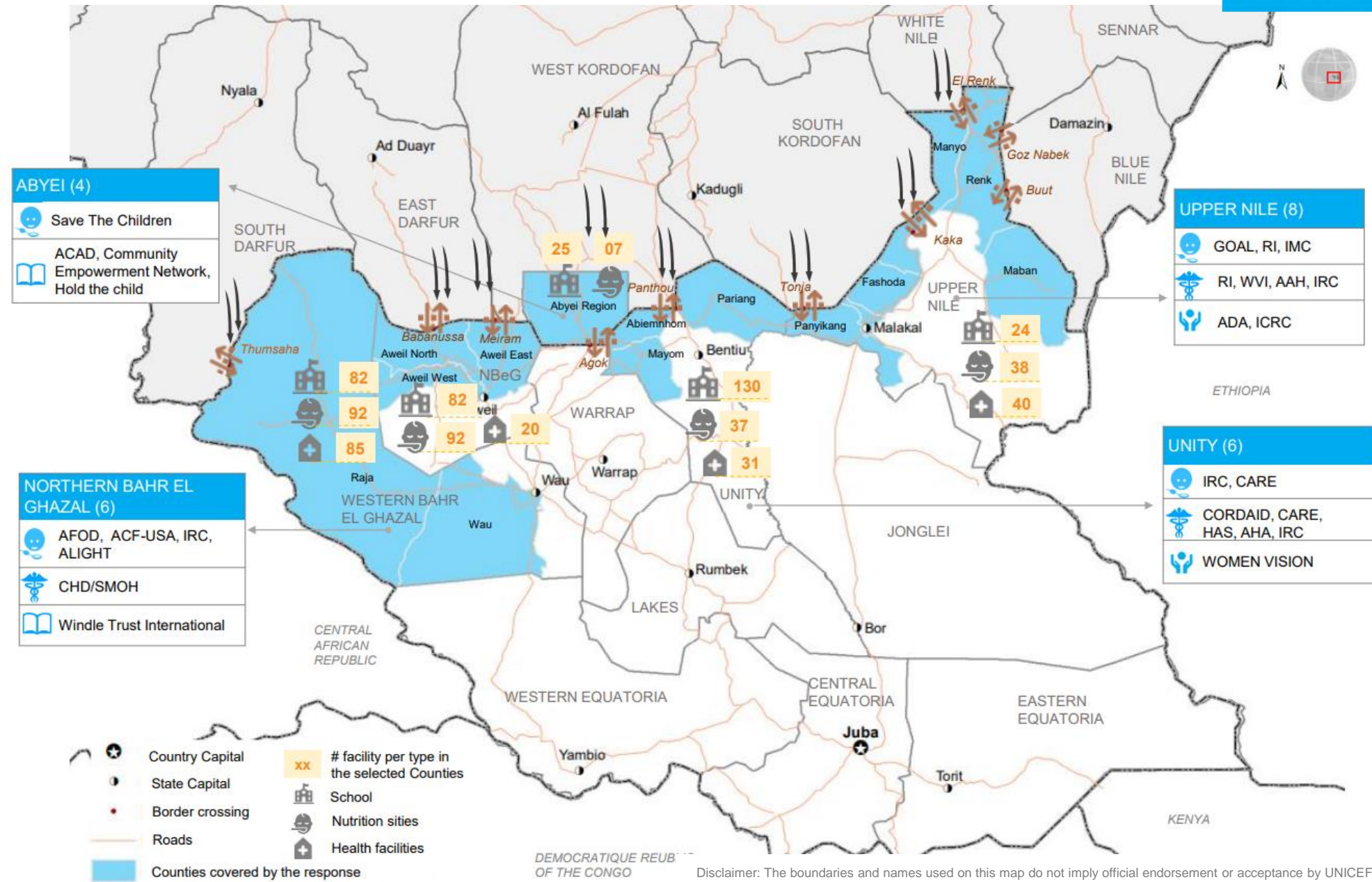
