8.3 Million - People in Need

8M South Sudanese (66% of all population) and **310K** Refugees in South Sudan (OCHA HNO, Jan 2021)



5.2 Million - People in Need

of **life-saving health care services**, the figure includes 50% female and 52% children (HRP Mar 2021)



2.7 Million Children in Need of Protection Services

Vulnerable children exposed to risks of recruitment by armed group, family separation, psychosocial distress, sexual violence, etc. (HRP Mar 2021)



1.4 Million - Children

Projected to suffer from **Acute Malnutrition** (UNICEF, HAC, 2021)



Schools and learning institutions re-opened

149,802 learners (84,822 males, 64,980 female) were enrolled in schools through UNICEF support (SitRep May 2021)



Construction of Water Supply System in Urban/Pei-urban Communities

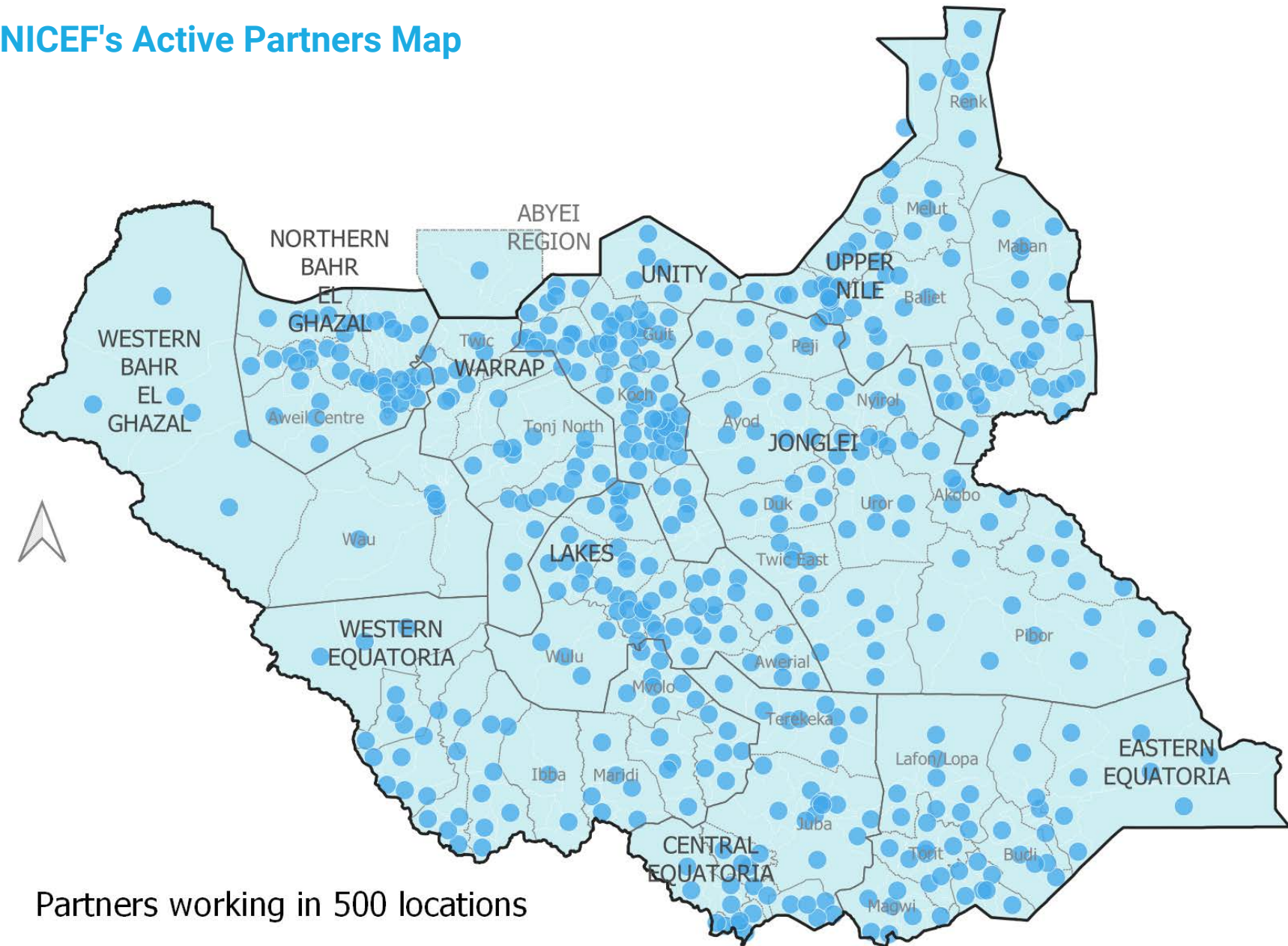
UNICEF Completed a Water Supply System in Juba. **103,000 individuals will be served with water** both in urban/peri-urban areas (SitRep May 2021)

Partners working in 500 locations



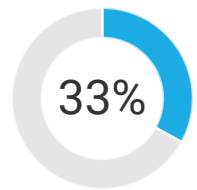

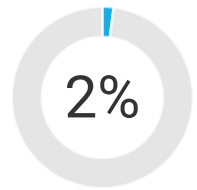

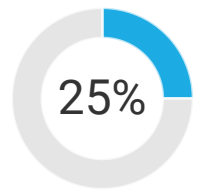

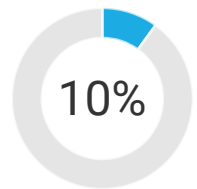

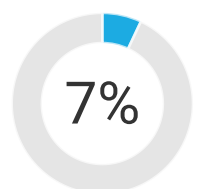

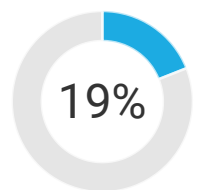

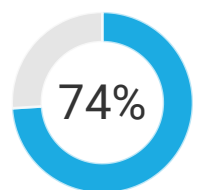

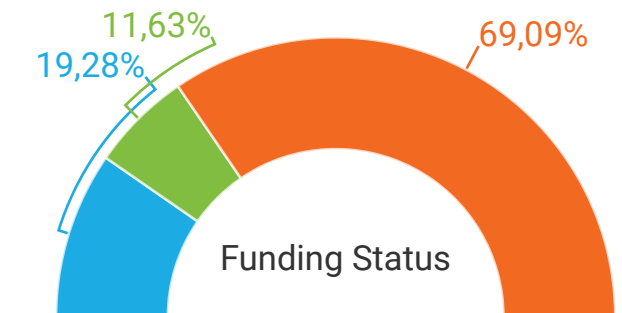
