8.3 Million - People in Need

8M South Sudanese (66% of all population) and 310K Refugees in South Sudan (OCHA, HNO, Jan 2021)



4.5 Million - Children in Need

of Humanitarian Assistance (OCHA, HNO, Jan 2021)



809 Thousand People - Affected by floods

Since Nov 2021, an estimated 809,000 people across the country have been affected by widespread flooding. (OCHA, UNHCR, Nov 2021)



2.7 Million Children in Need of Protection Services

Vulnerable children exposed to risks of recruitment by armed group, family separation, psychosocial distress, sexual violence, etc. (OCHA, HRP, Mar, 2021)

Since the beginning of the year (24,090 boys and 21,167 girls) (UNICEF SitRep Oct 2021)



195,436 Children Treated

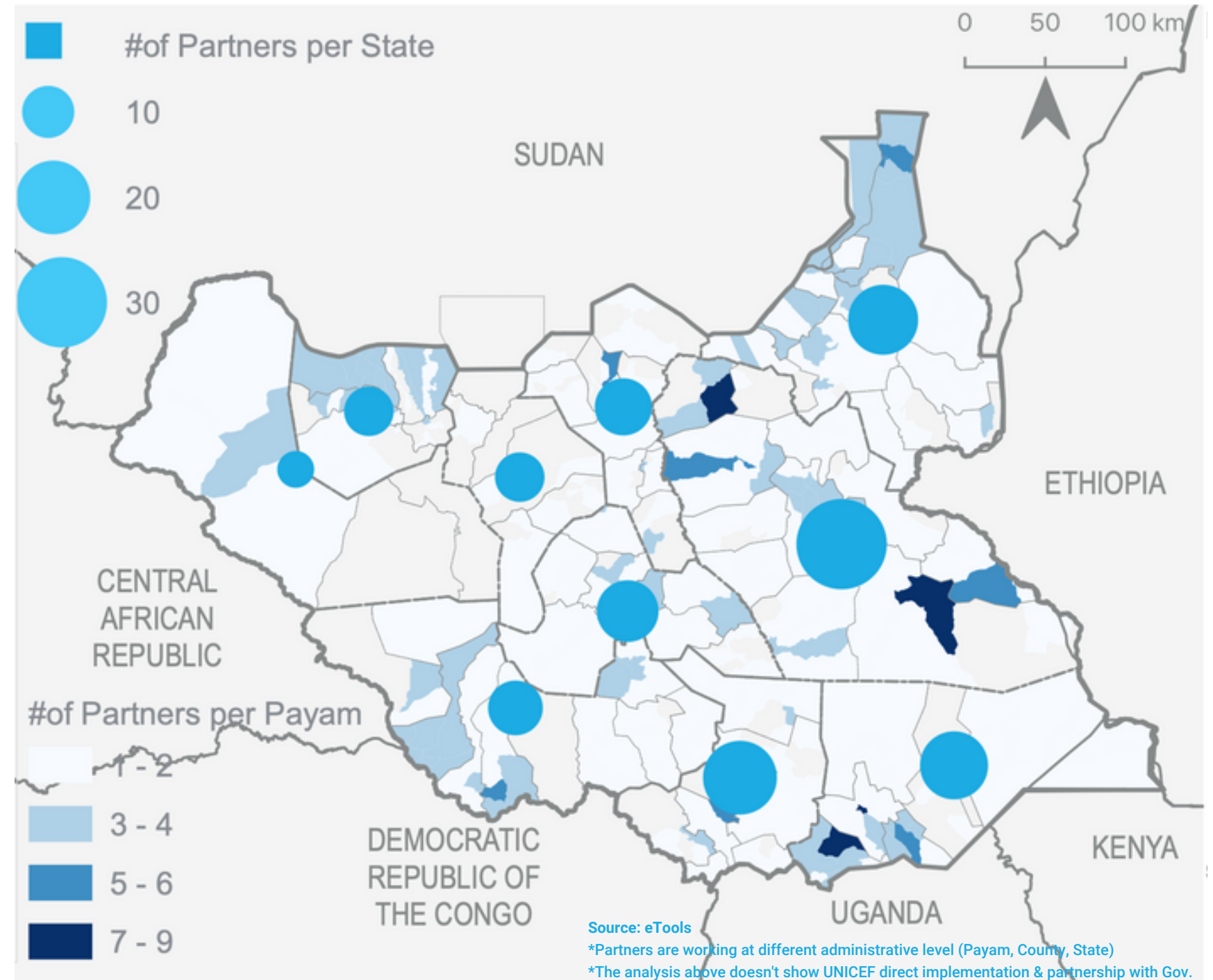
for severe acute malnutrition (106,304 girls and 89,132 boys) (UNICEF SitRep, Oct 2021)

Covering 377 payams. However, some partners works at State/County Level*

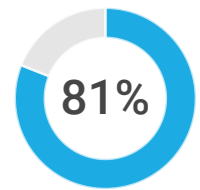

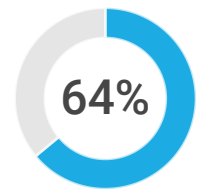

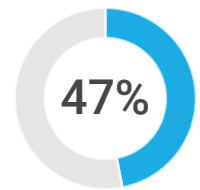

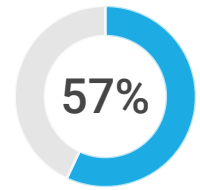
of children aged 6 to 59 months affected by SAM admitted for treatment

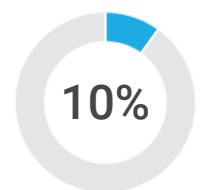
of children aged 6 months to 15 years vaccinated against measles

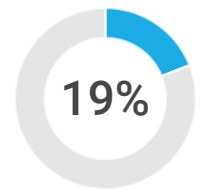
of people accessing a sufficient quantity of safe water for drinking, cooking and personal hygiene

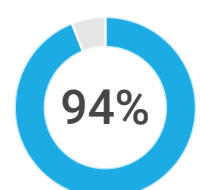
of children reached with psychosocial support services

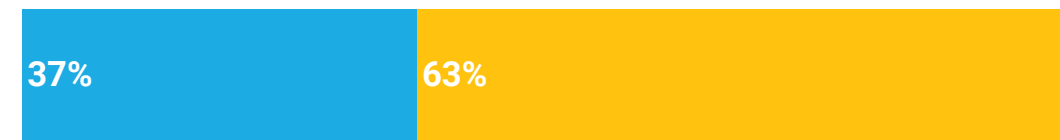

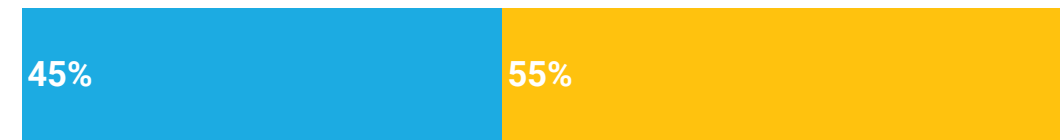
