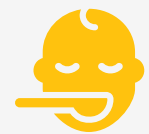
8.3 Million - People in Need

8 M South Sudanese (66% of all population) and 310K Refugees in South Sudan (OCHA, HNO, Jan 2021)



4.5 Million - Children in Need

of Humanitarian Assistance (OCHA, HNO, Jan 2021)



313 Thousand Children in Need of SAM Treatment

An estimated 313,391 children in need of severe acute malnutrition treatment in 2022. (UNICEF, HAC, Jan 2022)



5.9 Million - People Lack Access to Safe Water

Only 36 per cent of households report having access to an improved water source in under 30 minutes without facing protection concerns. (UNICEF, HAC, Jan 2022)



4,608 Children Reached with Psychosocial Support

Since the beginning of the year (2,446 boys and 2,162 girls). (UNICEF, SitRep Jan 2022)



23,467 Children Treated

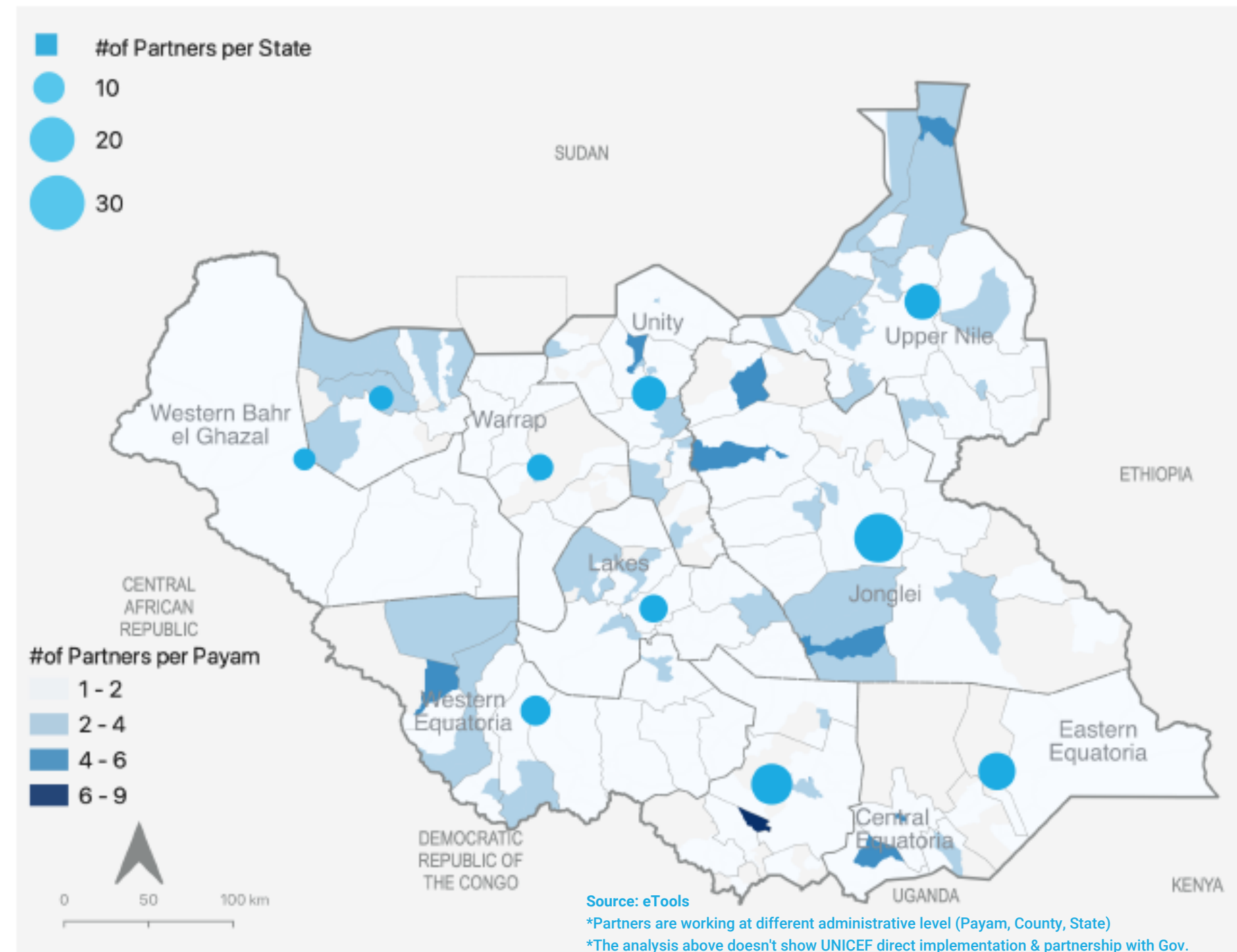
for severe acute malnutrition (12,836 girls and 10,631 boys). (UNICEF, SitRep Jan 2022)

Covering 421 payams. However, some partners works at State/County Level*

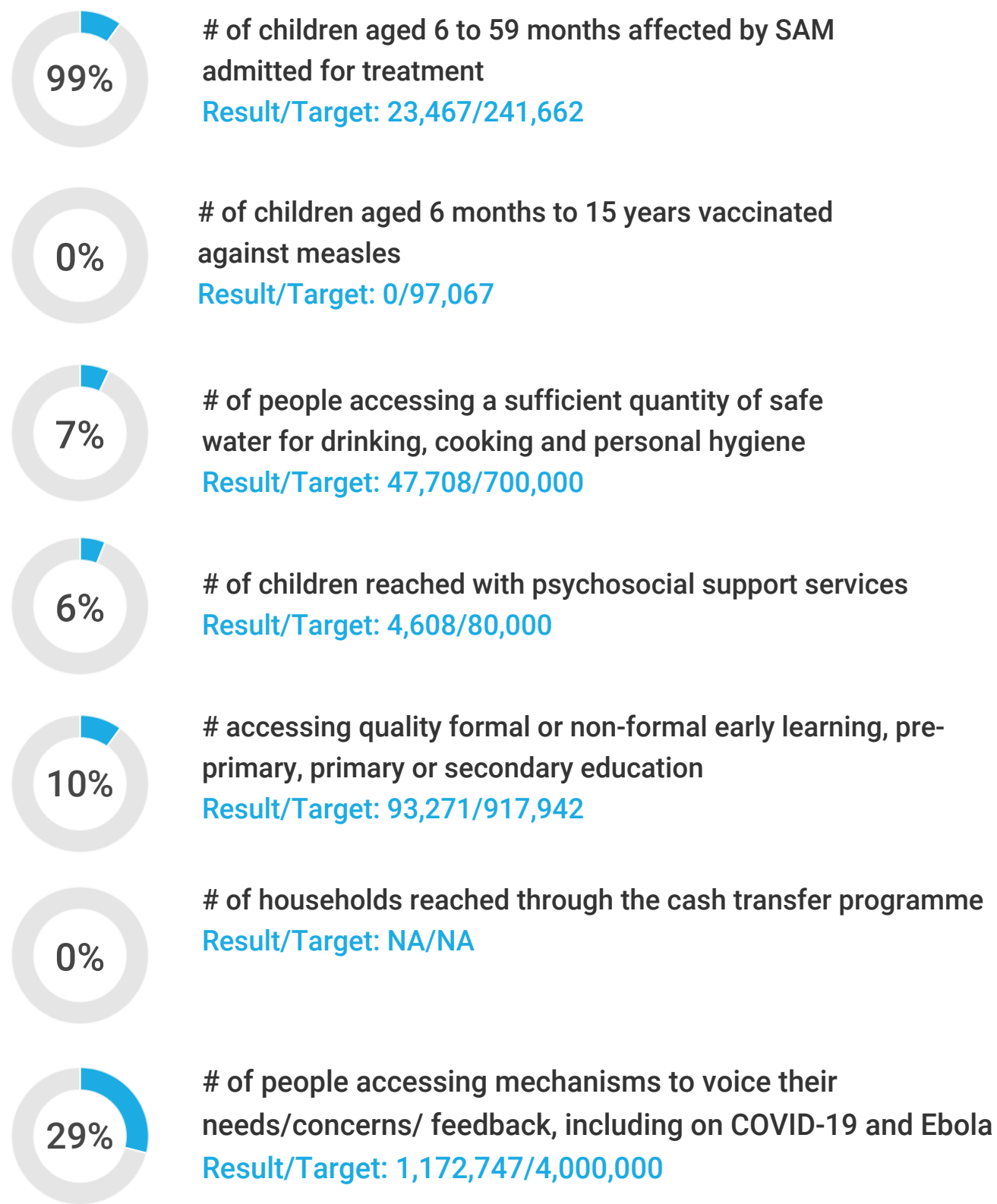

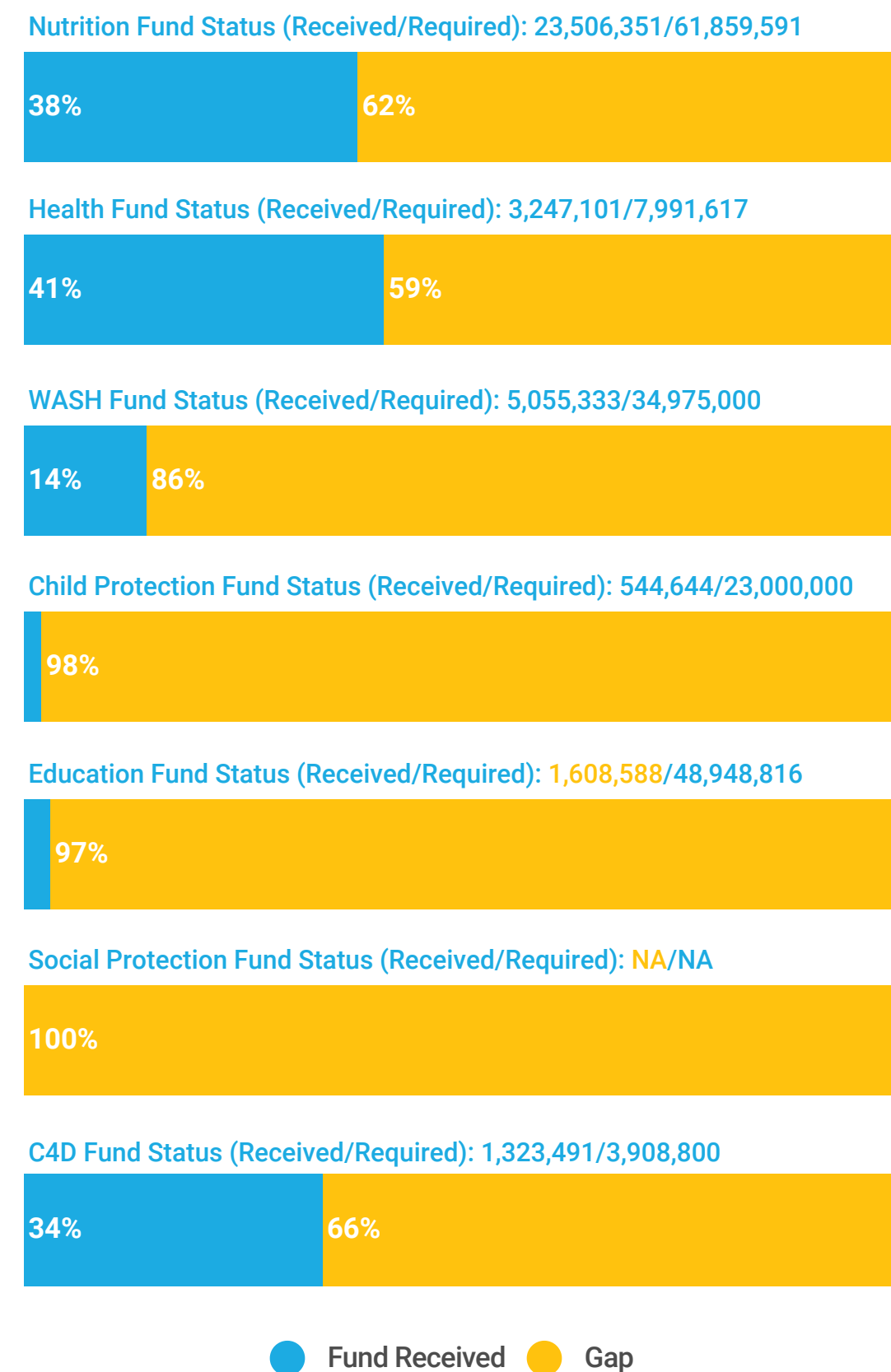
