Please note the following corrections in **bold**:

Main Report

Page 3

Second sentence in the third paragraph should read: Evidence from around the world shows just how precarious that decade can be: **81,000 Brazilian adolescents, 15–19 years old, were murdered between 1998 and 2008.**³
