2022 was a challenging year for Sudan with a deteriorating humanitarian situation. Conflicts, political and economic instability, epidemics, steadily increasing food insecurity and disruption to basic services have left children and families at-risk.

No matter the situation, UNICEF and partners continue to stay and deliver for the children most in need. In 2022, we reached millions of girls and boys with life-sustaining interventions, which would not have been possible without our partners' support.

Thanks to the support from all our implementing and donor partners, UNICEF can continue its mission to meet the needs and fulfil the rights of the most vulnerable children, their families and communities.
